It is hereby made known for general infonnation that the Member of the Executive Council responsible for Housing, Local Government and Traditional Affairs has, under the powers vested in her by section 3 of the House of Traditional Leaders Act (Eastern Cape), 1995 (Act No.1 of 1995), and after taking into consideration the recommendations of the Portfolio Committee of Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, on Housing, Local Government and Traditional Affairs, amended Provincial Notice No. 13 of 2005 published in Provincial Gazette No. 1326 of 2005, by the substitution for the Schedule thereto of the Schedule hereto.

1. Definitions

In these rules, unless the context otherwise indicate>, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear that meaning, and -

Constitution" means the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, Act No. 108 of 1996;

"department" means the Department responsible for traditional affairs in the Province;

<u>"electoral college</u>" means a group of candidates selected by various imbizos within a particular constituency;

"House of Traditional Leaders" or *"House"* mears the House of Traditional Leaders established by section 2 of the Act;

"imbizo" means a community meeting;

<u>"MEC" means member of Executive Council responsible for traditional affairs in the Province;</u>

<u>"presiding officer"</u> means a person designated by the head of department to preside over an imbizo or an electoral college;

"Province" means the Province of the Eastern Cape;

["region" means a tarrttorlal area referred to in the Annexure hereto;]

"regional authority" means a regional authority established in terms of a law contemplated in item 2 of Schedule 6 to the Constitution

<u>"Royal Family "means the Royal family as defined in the Traditional Leadership</u> and Governance Act (Eastern Cape) 2005 (Act No.4 of 2005); <u>Usecretary</u>" means an officer of the department who is responsible for the administration of a traditional council;

"the Act" means the House of Traditional Leaders Act (Eastern Cape), 1995 (Act No. 1 of 1995);

<u>"traditional communityll means a traditional community as defined in the Traditional Leadership and Governance Act (Eastern Cape), 2005 (Act NO.4 of 2005);</u>

<u>"traditional council"</u> means a traditional council as defined in the <u>Traditional</u> Leadership and <u>Governance Act (Eastern Cape)</u>, 2005 (Act NO.4 of 2005); and

<u>Utraditionalleader</u>" means a traditional leader as cefined in the Traditional Leadership and Governance Act (Eastern Cape), 2(105 (Act No.4 of 2005).</u>

2. Selection of candidates for nomination

(1) (a) The MEG must by notice in the *Provincial Gazette*, determine the date on which a [community meeting] imbizo must be **held** by each traditional [authority] <u>community within the constituencies sel</u> out in the Annexure hereto,
[in the Province] for purposes of selecting candidates from amongst whom the members of the House of Traditional Leaders will be nominated in terms of rule 3.

(b) A <u>traditional leader</u> who is a head of a traditional community must, in respect of his or her area of jurisdiction, convene **the**: [community meeting] imbizo which must be held on the date determined ill terms of paragraph (a).

(2) The meetings contemplated in sub rule (1) must be presided over by [the head of the relevant traditional authority] the presiding officer.

(3) All the meetings referred to in sub rule (1) must, subject to rule 4(7) (k), be held on the same day throughout the Province.

(4) The traditional leaders and members of the community present at each meeting must select three candidates who will, as provided in rule 3(2), participate in the nomination of the members of the House of Traditional Leaders and who will represent each constituency in the House in accordance with the Annexure hereto.

(5) If one of the of candidates selected in terms of sub rule(4) does not accept selection the meeting must select another candidate to replace the declining candidate.

[(5)] <u>(6)</u> The procedure to be followed in selecting the three candidates is as follows: [must be determined by those **attending** imbizo.]

- (a) <u>The presiding officer must explain the provisions of section 5 and 6 of the Act;</u>
- (b) The selection process must be by show of hand;
- (c) <u>The presiding officer must call for selection of candidates who are not</u> disqualified from being members in terms of section 6 of the Act;
- (d) <u>A candidate whose name has been proposed must be seconded by at least one person;</u>
- (e) <u>A selected candidate must rise and indicate whether he or she accepts the selection and must declare that he or she **guelifies** in terms of the Act:</u>
- (f) <u>Th e selected members must be comprised of at least 1/3 of women per traditional community.</u>;
- (g) <u>The presiding officer must in writing submit the names of the selected</u> <u>candidates to the head of department within 2 days from the date of the</u> <u>community meeting:</u>
- (h) <u>The head of department must publish the names of all the selected</u> <u>candidates in the *Provincial* Gazettewithin 7 days from the date of the <u>community meetings.</u></u>

[(6)] **ill** The three persons selected in terms of this \cdot ule must be persons who are traditional leaders.

3. Nomination by each constituency of members of the house

[(1) The secretary of each traditional authority must in writing, notify the relevant magistrate referred to in rule 4(2) of the names of the three candidates selected by each traditional authority in the Province in terms if rule 2.]

(1) The head of department must in writing notify the presiding officer for each electoral college of the names of the candidates who will constitute the electoral college.

(2) (a) The traditional leaders selected in terms of rule 2 must, within a constituency, constitute a single electoral college in respect of that constituency and the electoral colleges so constituted must nominate the members of the House from amongst their number.

(b) The number of persons to be nominated in respet of each constituency must be equal to the number of representatives allocated 1:0 each particular constituency in accordance with the Annexure hereto. (4) (a) Subject to <u>sub rule 2</u> (b) [paragraph (b)], no traditional leader must be <u>nominated</u> [selected] as a candidate unless such a traditional leader is qualified to be a member of the House in terms of the Act.

4. Procedural matters relating to nomination at atectors! <u>colleges</u> [of members of the house]

(1) (a) The electoral colleges constituted in terms of rule 3(2) must meet on the same day at the seats of the constituencies which have jurisdiction in each constituency referred to in the Annexure.

(b) The MEC must, by notice in the *Provincial Gazette*, determine the date on which the meetings contemplated in paragraph (a) must be held.

(2) <u>The head of department must cause electoral cc, lleges to be convened at the seat of the electoral college as provided for in the A 1nexure hereto.</u> [A magistrate of the district in which the seat of the constituency concerned is situate must convene and preside over the mee1ing at which members of the House of Traditional Leaders will be norninated.]

(3) The meeting at which nominations will take place must be open to the public but no member of the public must participate in the nomination process, or in any discussion relating thereto, whilst the meeting is in progress.

(4) The head of department [responsible for traditional affairs] must identify officers from the department who will assist the [mclgistrate] <u>presiding officers</u> amongst others, to take record of the proceedings.

(5) A candidate selected for nomination in terms of rule 2 must be entitled to vote at the meeting of the electoral college concerned and must have one vote.

(6) The [chairperson] <u>presiding officer</u> [presiding over] of each electoral college must cause the proceedings of such college to be recorded in such a manner as he or she may direct.

(7) (a) The [chairperson] <u>presiding officer</u> at a rneeting of an electoral college must call for the nomination of candidates from amongst the persons selected in terms of rule 2.

(b) A person so nominated must rise and indicate whether he or she accepts the nomination or not.

(c) The nomination of a candidate must be **seconded** by at least three persons entitled to vote at the meeting and who are from different traditional [authorities] <u>communities</u>.

(d) If the number of persons nominated at the meeting exceeds the number of persons who may be nominated for a particular constituency in terms of the <u>Annexure</u>, the [Chairperson] <u>presiding officer</u> must call upon the members of the electoral college concerned to vote for the members of the House by secret ballot.

(e) A traditional leader who has been nominated **may** decline his or her nomination at any time during the course of the meetinq.

(f) Should a ballot be necessary, the ballot paper must contain all the names of the nominees in alphabetical order in the same print with space next to each name to allow for the exercise of choice by means of a mark on the said paper.

(9) Each voler must vote by placing a cross (X) on the ballot paper opposite the name of the nominee for whom he or she wishes to vote and each such ballot paper must be folded inwards.

(h) The [chairperson] <u>presiding officer</u> must provide ballot boxes and such ballot boxes must be opened at the election before voting takes place to demonstrate to the voters that the boxes are empty.

(i) The [chairperson] <u>presiding officer</u> or any other person assisting <u>him or her</u> [the chairperson] in the election must maintain **secrecy** and must not attempt to ascertain, or directly, or indirectly aid in ascertaining. for which nominee any voter has voted. The head of department must <u>provide</u> a code of conduct for the presiding officers and the officers of the department which must be binding on them.

(j) Each voter must put the ballot paper into a ballot box.

(k) The election process must continue until all **voters** present have voted: Provided that such election must not proceed beyond seventeen hours (17:00) on the day concerned: Provided further that the election may continue on the following day if unforeseen circumstances necessitate this.

(1) The chairperson and the persons assisting him $_{OT}$ her in terms of rule 4(4) must be responsible for the counting of votes.

(rn) The counting must commence immediately after voting.

(n) The procedure outlined above must be repeated until the electoral college concerned has nominated persons who, in number, are equal to the number of representatives each constituency is entitled to in accordance with the Annexure.

(0) The procedure set out above must be followed in case of further nomination being necessary for the filling of vacancies.

(8)[Kings must designate their representatives to the House in writing, and a letter of designation must be submitted by the King concerned in respect of each representative to the MEC for publication in terms of rule 5.] Where a King or a Queen does not assume his or her seat in the house and decides to appoint a representative in terms of section 3 of the Act, the following procedure must apply:

- (1) <u>The King or the Queen must advise the head of department in writing, of</u> <u>the name of his or her nominee within 2 days from the date of the electoral</u> <u>college.</u>
- (2) <u>Such representative must be a member of a Royal family who is recognised</u> as a traditional leader.
- (3) <u>Such representative must serve for the period of the term of the house</u> unless <u>he or she is disqualified in terms of section 6 of Act.</u>
- (4) <u>The MEC must publish or cause to be published the Provincial Gazette,</u> <u>the names of the representatives together with the names of the members</u> <u>who have been nominated by the respective constituencies.</u>
- (5) <u>A representative of a King must enjoy privileges</u>, rights, functions, powers and shall have the same obligations as any other member of the House.

5. Results of elections

The results of the nomination processes must be pJblished or caused to be published by the MEC by notice in the *Provincial Gazette*, immediately after they all become available to him or her.

6. Vacation of seat by member of the house

A traditional leader who is a member of the House must on being elected to the national House of Traditional Leaders, be deemed to have vacated his or her seat in the House, and the resultant vacancy must be filled in accordance with rules 2,3 and 4.

7. Transitional Provisions

Any act performed or decision taken in terms of the rules published in Notice No. 13 of 2005 in *Provincial Gazette* No.8 of 2005 is valid and must be deemed to be performed or taken in terms of the these rules.
