6. Take such steps as the Board considers desirable for the encouragement of the development, achievement and maintenance of satisfactory standards in hotels, restaurants, or other places and of things affording or proposed to afford amenities or facilities to tourists within the Province;
7. Obtain and provide advice and guidance in connection with the establishment, expansion or conduct of hotels, restaurants, or other places and of things affording or proposed to afford amenities to tourists or tourism; and
8. Encourage the adoption of measures for providing training and instruction for persons employed or intending to take up employment in the hotel or catering industry.

Kindly note that Section 11 of the Act disqualifies the following persons from appointment:-

- A person holding office as a member of Parliament, a provincial legislature or a municipal council;
- A person who has been removed from office in terms of section 8;
- A public servant other than a person contemplated by section 5(1); and
- A person convicted of a criminal offence of which dishonesty is an element.

A fully motivated application, accompanied by a Curriculum Vitae, proof of South African citizenship, as well as a Sworn Declaration that the applicant is not disqualified in terms of the Act, should be submitted to **on or before 16h00, Friday 29th February 2008** to:




