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

PART 8**ESTABLISHMENT OF A LOCAL MUNICIPALITY**

1. A local municipality is hereby established.

The local municipality indicated as EC 103 includes the north western portion of ECDMA10 surrounding the area of Wolwefontein into Ikwezi Local Municipality

CATEGORY

2. The local municipality is a Category B municipality as determined by the Demarcation Board in terms of section 4 of the Act.

TYPE

3. The local municipality is of a type described in section 3(f) of the Determination of Types of Municipality Act, Act 2000 (Act 5 of 2000 (EC)).

BOUNDARIES

4. The boundaries of the local municipality are as indicated on Map No. DC 10_EC 103 published in provincial Gazette No. 1904 (extraordinary) dated 30 May 2008 and/or any subsequent amendment by the Demarcation Board.

WARDS

5. The local municipality has 4 wards determined by the Demarcation Board

NAME

6. The name of the local municipality is Ikwezi Local Municipality

7. COUNCILLORS

- (1) The council of the local municipality consists of 7 councilors as determined in Provincial Notice No 67 published in Provincial Gazette No. 2234 (Extraordinary) dated 12 November 2009.
- (2) Full time councilors, if any, are designated in accordance with the policy framework contemplated in section 18(4) of the Act.

8. FULLTIME COUNCILLORS

The council of the local municipality may, subject to the conditions contained in paragraph 7(2) in this Part, designate the following office bearer as fulltime:

- (a) Speaker

9. SEAT OF FIRST MEETING

The seat of the new municipality for the purpose of the first meeting of its council after effective date shall continue to be Jansenville which shall be deemed to be the seat of the municipality until determined otherwise in terms of the Act.

10. MUNICIPAL MANAGER

The existing municipal manager is designated in terms of section 29(2) of the Act to call the first meeting of the council of the municipality.

11. STANDING RULES FOR FIRST MEETING

The existing standing rules and order for the first meeting of the new municipality shall be as follows:

12. Definitions

In these rules, unless inconsistent with the context –

A word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Municipal Structures Act has the same meaning;

‘municipal manager’ means the existing acting municipal manager;

“seat of the municipality” means the existing seat of the local municipality;
and

“Municipal Structures Act” means the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act 117 of 1998);

13. Notice convening first meeting

- (1) The municipal manager must, within 3 days after council has been declared elected, inform the elected councillors in writing of the venue, date, and time of the first meeting of council.
- (2) The first meeting of the council must take place at the existing seat of the municipality within 14 days after the council has been declared elected.

14. Convening notice read and oath or affirmation

(1) At the commencement of proceeding of the council at the first meeting after it has been convened in terms of section 29 of the Municipal Structures Act, the municipal manager must read the notice convening the council.

(2) After the notice convening the council has been read, the councillors must swear or affirm faithfulness to the Republic and obedience to the Constitution.

15.Election of Speaker

- (1) At its first meeting after its election the council must elect its speaker from among its councillors.
- (2) The a municipal manager presides over the election of the Speaker.
- (3) The procedure set out in Schedule 3 of the Municipal Structures Act applies to the election of the speaker
- (4) The Speaker of a council of a municipality of the type mentioned in sections 9(e) or(f) or 10(c) of the Municipal Structures Act must be called a Mayor
- (5) The elected Speaker presides over the remainder of the first meeting of the council and may express a sense of honour conferred upon him/her

16.Quorums and decisions

The quorums and determinations required by section 30 of the Municipal Structures Act apply to the first meeting of council.

17.Procedure for matters not dealt with in the Rules

A by-law relating to the procedure and maintenance of order at meetings, subject to the provision of the Municipal Structures act, applies to any procedural matter not provided for in the rules.
