

ACT

To appropriate additional amounts of money for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements for the Financial year ending 31 March 2011 and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

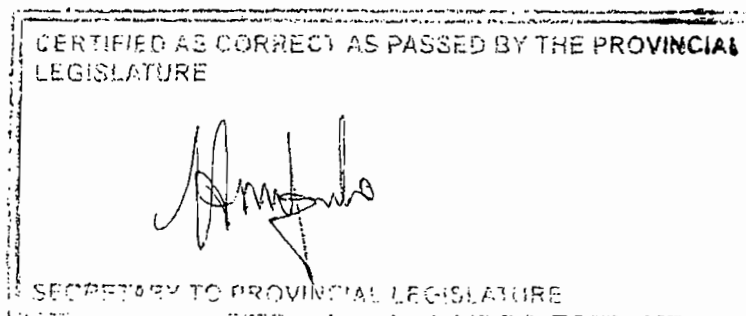
BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, as follows:-

Appropriation of an additional amount of money for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements

1. Subject to the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), there is hereby appropriated adjusted amounts of money from the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements as an additional amount under transfers in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2011, the adjusted amount of R39,000 million (thirty nine million) as shown in the schedule hereto.

Short title

2. This Act is called the Second Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2011 (Eastern Cape).
