AND TOURISM****No. 3****NATURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION ORDINANCE, 1974
(ORDINANCE NO. 19 OF 1974): AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 4**

I, **Mcebisi Jonas**, Member of the Executive Council for Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEDEAT), acting in terms of section 77 and 79 of the Nature and Environmental Conservation Ordinance, 1974 (Ordinance No. 19 of 1974) hereby -

- (a) amend with effect from 1st of October 2011, schedule 4 of the said Ordinance by the addition thereto after the reference Family: "*EUPHORBIACEAE*" All species/"of the following family and species of flora:

"Family: *FABACEAE*"

Mountain tea

Cyclopia intermedia

Marshland tea

Cyclopia subternata

(b) prohibit the picking and trading without permit of all the species listed under family: Fabaceae, in the said schedule 4.
