



APPROVED 2012 / 2013 ANNUAL BUDGET AND INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PLAN

AMENDMENT TO RATES AND TARIFFS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Senqu Municipal Council has in terms of section 24 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, No 56 of 2003, approved its Annual Operational and Capital Budget on the 31th of May 2012. As required in terms of section 17 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, the Budget, Integrated Development Plan and Supporting Documents were tabled and advertised for representations / submissions by the local community, Provincial and National Treasury on the 30th March 2012 and 10th April 2012 respectively. All representations / submissions received before the 4th May 2012 were dealt with by council where after an operational budget of R 144 207 330 and a capital budget of R 45 153 750 were approved. Copies of the approved 2012 / 2013 Annual Budget and supporting documents are available at the Lady Grey, Barkly East and Sterkspruit administrative units of Senqu Municipality.

Refuse Removal tariffs would increase by 6.00% as from the 1st July 2012.

Electricity tariffs would increase by 11.03% once approved by the National Energy Regulator (NER).
