



LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE 34

"Under Section 5 of the Eastern Cape Roads Act (Act 3 of 2003) the Eastern Cape MEC of Transport, Roads and Public Works hereby gives notice that:

- 1. A portion of Minor Road 43, situated in the Inxuba Yethemba Municipal area, as was proclaimed in Gazette No 2908 of 1958 as Minor road 43 and with the following description is now closed as a public road. Commencing from the point the minor road 43 enters the Farm Groot Dam(47) from the north-west across farms Groot Dam(47), Lange Rif(44), Honingkrantz(151) and Gunsteling (REM.165) to its intersection with TR04901 (R61).
- 2. A portion of Minor Road 10223, situated in Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality, as was proclaimed in Gazette no 2083 of 1956 as minor road 79: Elfin Glen Road and as described as follows is closed as a provincial minor road. Commencing from the N2/R72 and traverses through what are now the suburbs of Abbortsford and Nahoon Valley Park to the point the existing minor road crosses onto the farm Portion 123 of Farm 86. All public streets within the suburbs of Abbortsford and Nahoon Valley Park designated as such in terms of the approved township layouts remain as public streets under the authority of the Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality.
