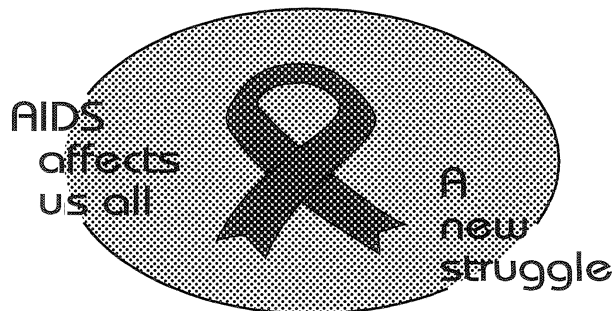

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

SCHEDULE

REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT, COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONING OF AN INTERIM EASTERN CAPE ARTS AND CULTURE COUNCIL

1. Definitions

In these Regulations, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act, has that meaning and, unless the context otherwise indicates-

“**Act**” means the Eastern Cape Arts and Culture Council Act, 2000 (Act No. 6 of 2000);

“**council**” means the Eastern Cape Arts and Culture Council established in terms of section 2 of the Act;

“**Interim Council**” means the Eastern Cape Arts and Culture Interim Council established in term of section 14(1)(b) of the Act;

“**MEC**” means the member of the Executive Council responsible for arts and culture in the Province;

“**Province**” means the Province of the Eastern Cape.

2. Appointment of Interim Council

(1) The MEC may appoint an Interim Council within 60 days after the dissolution or termination of term the council to fulfil the functions of the council as prescribed by the Act.

(2) The term office of the Interim Council is a period not exceeding one year.

3. Composition of the Interim Council

(1) The Interim Council must consist of between six to eight members and the MEC does not have to follow the nomination and appointment procedure contemplated in the Act.

(2) The MEC must appoint the chairperson and deputy chairperson of the Interim Council.

4. Application of the provisions of the Act to the Interim Council

The provisions of the Act relating to the Council shall apply to the Interim Council.

5. Short title and commencement

These Regulations are called the Regulations to provide for the Appointment, Composition and Functioning of an Interim Eastern Cape Provincial Arts and Culture Council and shall commence upon publication in the Government Gazette.
