 - 1.1.deleting and amending the restrictive conditions set forth at paragraph 2(d) and 3(d) of the Title Deed number T49352/2001 in respect of the property described therein as Erf 373 Mill Park, in the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality, Division of Port Elizabeth, Province of the Eastern Cape, (hereinafter referred to as "the property") to wit:

"2. SUBJECT to the following special conditions contained in the Deed of Transfer T4220/1934 imposed by the Administrator of the Province of the Cape of Good Hope, namely:-

(d) That all buildings to be erected on the said lot shall stand back not less than 20 feet from the line of the street or avenue on which the lot abuts. Suck space may be used as gardens, but shall not be built upon."
