## ACT NO. 3 OF 2015 (EC) SECOND ADJUSTMENTS APPROPRIATION ACT, 2015

**ACT**

**To appropriate an additional amount of money for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements for the financial year ending 31 March 2015; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.**

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, as follows:—

**Appropriation of additional amount of money for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements.**

1. Subject to the Provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No.1 of 1999), there is hereby appropriated an adjusted amount of R233 500 000.00 (two hundred and thirty three million five hundred thousand rand) from the Provincial Revenue for the requirements of the Department of Human Settlements in respect to the financial year ending 31 March 2015.
2. The amount of money contemplated in subsection (1) is an additional appropriation for Programme 3.





## ACT NO 2 OF 2015 (EC) EASTERN CAPE FINANCE ACT, 2015

**ACT**

To authorise certain unauthorised expenditure in respect of 2012/13 and 2013/14 financial years and to charge the Provincial Revenue Fund, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, as follows:—

**Authorisation of unauthorised expenditure from the Provincial Revenue Fund.**

1. (1) the unauthorised expenditure to the amount of R 51 400 185.41 incurred by the Eastern Cape Provincial Government during the period April 2012 to March 2013, and the amount of R62 785 807.37 incurred by the said province during the period April 2013 to March 2014, and which the relevant Standing Committee on Public Accounts recommended for authorisation by the Legislature, is hereby authorised.
- (2) The expenditure referred to in subsection (1) is more fully described in the reports of the Standing Committee on Public Accounts as listed in Schedule 1 hereunder.
- (3) The expenditure is a direct charge against the Provincial Revenue Fund as envisaged in Section 34(1)(a) of the Public Finance Management Act No.1 of 1999, as amended.

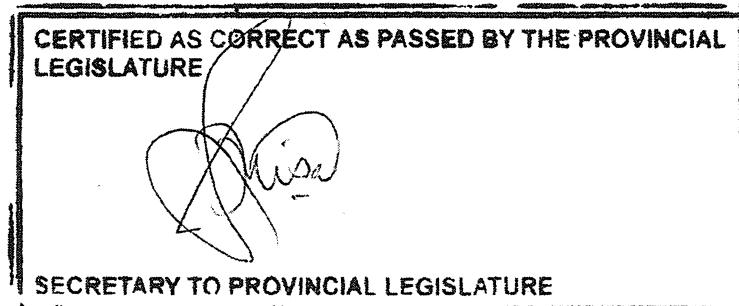
**Short title and commencement**

2. This Act is called the Eastern Cape Finance Act, 2015 and shall be effective from the date it is assented into law by the Premier.
