NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications for amendment of licence conditions in terms of section 35 of the Eastern Cape Gambling Act, 1997, particulars of which are set out in the schedules hereunder, have been lodged with the Eastern Cape Gambling Board.

The applications may be inspected by any person at the offices of the Eastern Cape Gambling Board, ECGB Building, Quenera Park, Quenera Drive, Beacon Bay, East London, Eastern Cape. The applications will also be uploaded on the Eastern Cape Gambling Board's website (www.ecgb.org.za).

Any objections, petitions or representations shall be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer of the Board within one (1) month of the date of this notice, which commences on **31 May 2021 until 30 June 2021**.

All objections and comments shall specify: the application to which the objection or comment relates; the grounds on which the objection is founded; in the case of comment; full particulars or facts in substantiation thereof; the name, address, telephone and fax number of the objector or person making the comment and a statement whether the objector or person making the comment wishes to make oral representations when the application is heard.

A person lodging representations may show cause why the Board may determine that his or her identity should not be divulged.
