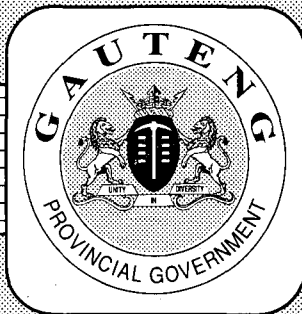

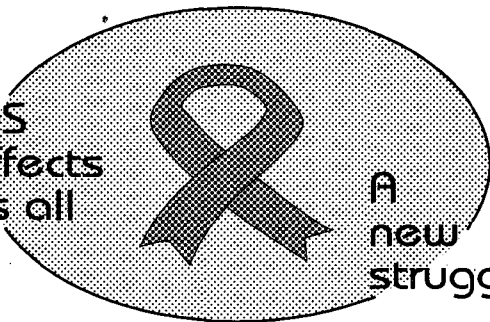

GENERAL NOTICE

NOTICE 7678 OF 2000

NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 47 OF THE SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT, 1995 (ACT No. 6 OF 1995)

I, Ignatius Patrick Jacobs, Member of the Executive Council for Education, Gauteng Province, after consultation with the governing bodies of the Public Pre-primary Schools mentioned in Schedule B, hereby declare that these Pre-primary Schools shall be closed with effect from 31 December 2000.

Should any of the hereinafter mentioned governing bodies feel aggrieved by its declaration, such governing body is entitled to appeal to the Executive Council in terms of section 47 (4) of the School Education Act, 1995 (Act No. 6 of 1995).

The reasons for the closure are contained in Schedule A.

SCHEDULE A

- (i) The existing public pre-primary model is not appropriate for all the children in Gauteng and is not replicable for all.
- (ii) The public pre-primary schools are located in the historically advantaged suburbs and therefore are not accessible to all.
- (iii) These schools were inherited from the ex-Transvaal Educational Department (TED) and originally served only White children.
- (iv) Although these schools now enroll children of all races they still serve only a small minority of pre-school children in Gauteng, whilst the vast majority of children have no access to Early Childhood Development services at all.
- (v) Gauteng at present has just under 1 million children under the age of six, whereas public pre-primary schools have never served more than approximately 12 000 children at any given time.
- (vi) The Government cannot justify the provisioning imbalances within this sector.
- (vii) The budgeted salary bill for this sector is annually standing at approximately R48 million, which could be used to reach out to more needy children in a form of subsidies to Early Childhood Development Services.
