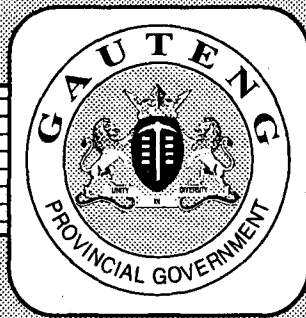

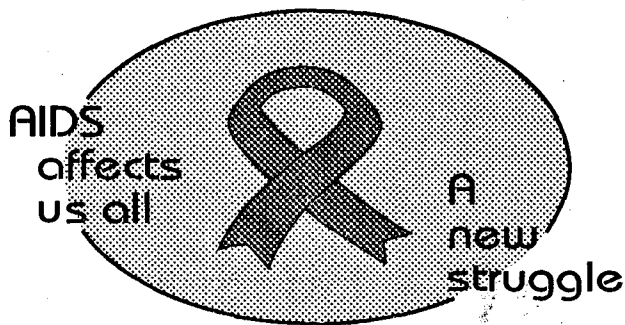

It is hereby notified that the Premier has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:

No. 7 of 1999: Provincial Adjustments Appropriation Act, 1999.

ACT

To appropriate adjusted amounts of money for the requirements of the Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2000

*(English text signed by the Premier)
(Assented to on 4 May 2000)*

BE IT ENACTED by the Provincial Legislature of Gauteng, as follows:

1. Subject to the provisions of the Provincial Exchequer Act, 1994 (Act No. 1 of 1994), there are hereby appropriated out of the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2000, as a charge to the Provincial Revenue Account, the adjusted amounts of money shown in column 1 of the Schedule.

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Provincial Adjustments Appropriation Act, 1999.
