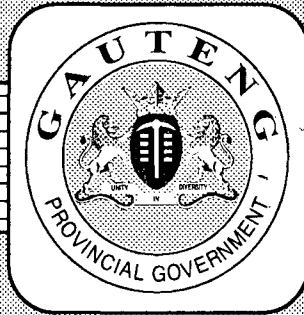

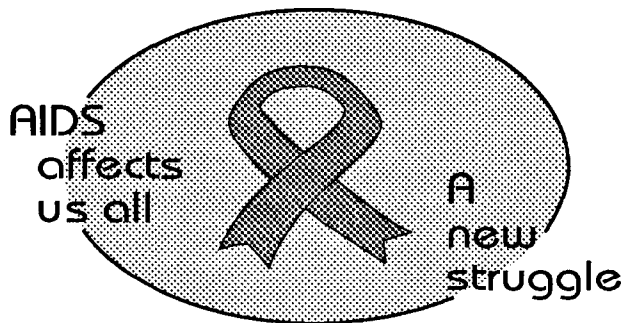

**GENERAL NOTICE****NOTICE 3335 OF 2000**

GAUTENG GAMBLING ACT, 1995

**APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF BOOKMAKER'S LICENCE**

Notice is hereby given that We, Glenn Sepel and Cyril Sepel, of Edenvale Tattersalls, intend submitting an application to the Gauteng Gambling Board for an amendment of a bookmaker's licence, to relocate from corner Smith and Terrace Roads, Edenglen, Edenvale, to Glen Curve Shopping Centre, Elm Street, Dowerglen, Edenvale. Our application will be open to public inspection at the offices of the Board from 24 May 2000 (Note 1).

Attention is directed to the provisions of section 20 of the Gauteng Gambling Act, 1995, which makes provision for the lodging of written representations in respect of the application.

Such representations should be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer, Gauteng Gambling Board, Private Bag X125, Centurion, 0046, within one month from 24 June 2000. Any person submitting representations should state in such representation whether or not they wish to make oral representations at the hearing of the application.

**Notes:**

1. Date to be included above and date of placing of advertisement to be arranged with the Board.
2. This notice must be placed in the *Provincial Gazette* as well as a newspaper circulating in the district in which the premises to which the application relates, are situated.
3. In the event of a partnership or a company applying, the wording of the advertisement must first be approved by the Board.
