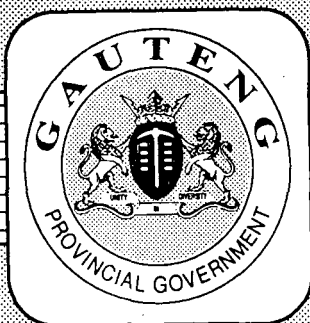

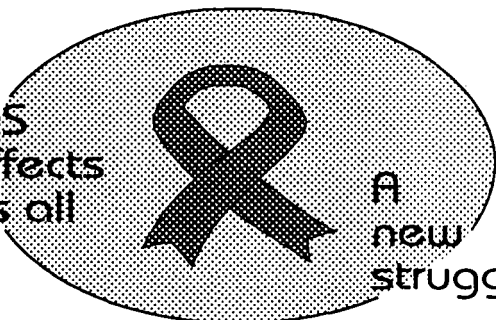

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PREMIER'S NOTICE

It is hereby notified that the Premier has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information:—

No. 2 of 2000: Provincial Appropriation Act, 2000.

ACT

To appropriate amounts of money for the requirements of the Province for the financial year ending 31 March 2001

*(English text signed by the Premier)
(Assented to on 15 June 2000)*

BE IT ENACTED by the Provincial Legislature of the Province of Gauteng, as follows:—

1. Subject to the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), there are hereby appropriated out of the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province during the financial year ending 31 March 2001, as a charge to the Provincial Revenue Account, the amounts of money shown in the Schedule to the Bill.

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Provincial Appropriation Act, 2000.

WITHDRAWAL OF PROVINCIAL NOTICE No. 6432 OF 24 SEPTEMBER 1999

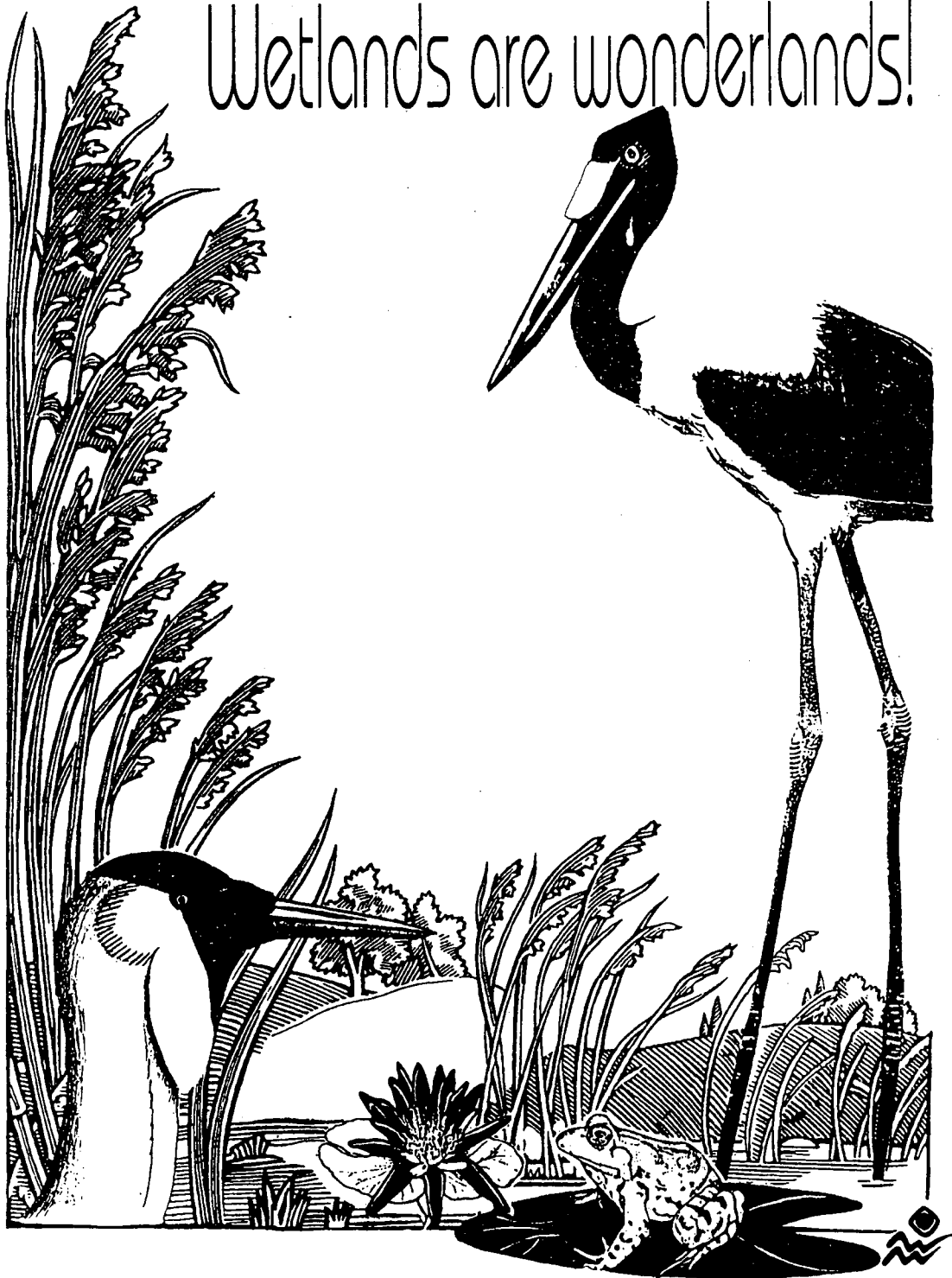
