CONDITIONS FOR RELEASE OF MOTOR VEHICLE

1. The seized and impounded motor vehicle will only be released under the following conditions:
 - a) Proof that the criminal proceedings relating to the unauthorised road transport for which the motor vehicle was specifically seized or impounded have been finalised.
 - b) Proof that the impoundment, storage and administrative fees of R1 000 or an amount prescribed in other laws related to motor vehicles have been paid, which is payable at Sage Life Building, corner Simmonds and Pritchardt Street, 8th Floor North Tower, Johannesburg.
 - c) On production of the impoundment receipt (Annexure "A"), and
 - d) Only to the motor vehicle owner upon satisfactory proof of ownership.

SCHEDULE

DEFINITIONS

1. In these regulations, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned by the Act, shall have the same meaning, and

"Pound" means an enclosed area designated for the storage and safekeeping of motor vehicles.

SEIZURE AND IMPOUNDMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

2. Upon seizure and impoundment of a motor vehicle in terms of Section 29 or any other Section of the Act or in terms of other laws related to motor vehicles, an authorised official, an inspector or a member of the South African Police Service must issue driver, operator or person in possession of the motor vehicle immediately before the seizure and impoundment of the motor vehicle with a receipt in the format prescribed in Annexure A.

STORAGE OF SEIZED AND IMPOUNDED MOTOR VEHICLES

3. Motor vehicle seized or impounded in terms of Section 29 or any other Section of the Act or in terms of other laws related to motor vehicles shall within a reasonable time of such seizure or impoundment, be taken to a pound designated and identified as such in Annexure B.

RELEASE OF SEIZED AND IMPOUNDED VEHICLES

4. The seized and impounded motor vehicle will only be released under the following conditions:
 - a) Proof that the criminal proceedings relating to the unauthorised road transport for which the motor vehicle was specifically seized or impounded have been finalised.
 - b) Proof that the impoundment, storage and administrative fees of R1 000 or an amount prescribed in other laws related to motor vehicles have been paid.
 - c) On production of the impoundment receipt (Annexure A), and
 - d) Only to the motor vehicle upon satisfactory proof of ownership.

SHORT TITLE

5. These regulations shall be known as the Gauteng Regulations on Impoundment and Disposal Procedures of Motor Vehicles.

COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICATION

6. These regulations shall come into operation upon publication in the Government Gazette and shall apply retrospectively to all acts of impoundment of motor vehicles conducted previously under the Act or other laws related to motor vehicles.
