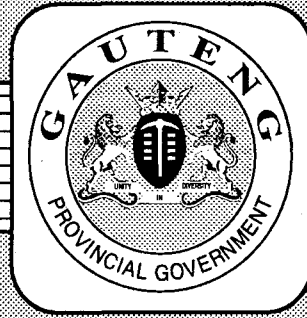

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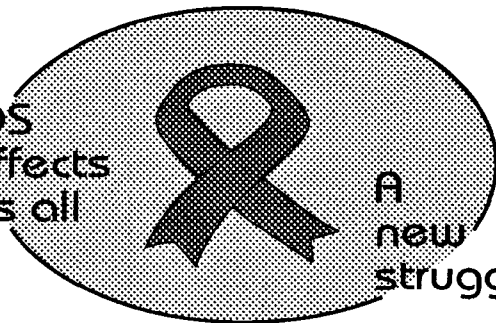

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## GENERAL NOTICE

### NOTICE 2591 OF 2001

#### AMENDMENTS TO THE NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 9 (3) SASA: MISCONDUCT OF LEARNERS AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS (NOTICE 144, 4 OCTOBER 2000)

1. Amendment: paragraph (2) is hereby amended to—  
“days” means days of the week, excluding Saturday, Sundays, public holidays and school holidays.
2. Addition: Paragraph 4 (5) is hereby an addition: A decision of such committee is a decision of the governing body.
3. Amendment: Paragraph 6 (1) is hereby amended to:  
Where a disciplinary committee in terms of paragraph 5 (15) suspends a learner from attending school with a view to expulsion by the Head of Department, the disciplinary committee must direct the principal to submit to the Head of Department the full record of proceedings and a report compiled by the disciplinary committee in respect of the learner.
4. Addition and amendment: Paragraph 6 (3) is hereby amended and added to.  
After considering the full record of the proceedings and the report contemplated in sub paragraph (1) and within 5 (five) days of being informed of the decision of the disciplinary committee, the Head of Department must—
  - (a) expel the learner; or
  - (b) impose on the learner a lesser punishment permitted by the code and this notice; or
  - (c) suspend or postpone a sentence referred to in sub paragraph (a) for a period of not less than six months; or
  - (d) impose a competent sentence which the Head of Department deems fit, or
  - (e) find the learner not guilty.
5. Amend: Paragraph 8 (1) (c) is hereby amended to:  
an order made by the Head of Department in terms of paragraph 6 (5).
6. Amend: Paragraph 8 (2) is hereby amended to:  
A learner or the parent of a learner who wishes to appeal against a decision contemplated in sub paragraph (1) must, within 14 (fourteen) days of being notified in terms of paragraph 6 (3) of the decision, hand deliver a notice of appeal together with the grounds for the appeal to the office of the Member of the Executive Council.
