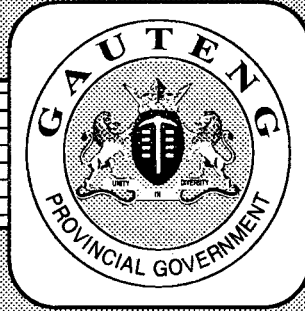

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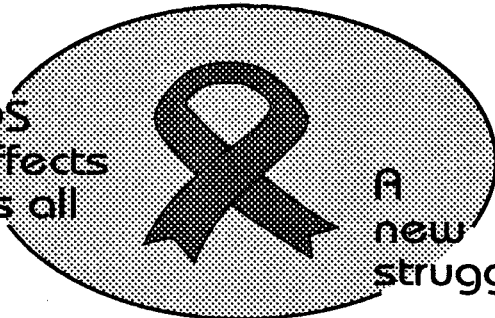

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**NOTICE 3578 OF 2002****DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT, ROADS AND WORKS****GAUTENG INTERIM MINIBUS TAXI-TYPE SERVICES ACT, 1997 (ACT NO. 11 OF 1997)****NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS TO CLOSE TAXI ROUTES AND RANKS IN TERMS OF SECTION 49 (7) OF THE ACT.**

I, **Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng**, having published regulations in terms of Section 49 (7) of the Act under **General Notice No. 3465** in the **Provincial Gazette Extra-ordinary No. 399 Vol. 8** dated **20 November 2002**, I now give notice of my intention to make amendments to the aforesaid regulations **published on 20 November 2002** to extend the regulations as contained in the schedule hereto.

- 1.1 **Routes**

- 1.1.1 **Park City Taxi Rank to Brakpan Station Taxi Rank**

**GJ0068 Route described as follows;** Noord Street, Wanderers Street, Bree Street, N17, R23 Heidelberg Road, Benoni Road, Airport Drive, M46 Athlone Drive, Van Der Walt Road, Voortrekker Road, Station Street, Brakpan Station Taxi Rank and back via Klein Street.

- 1.1.2 **Brakpan Station Taxi Rank to Johannesburg Taxi Rank**

**GE0357 Route described as follows;** Alberton Road, Heidelberg Road, N17, Pretoria Road, Harrow Road, Anderson Street, Troye Street, Commissioner Street, Von Weilligh Street, Klein Street, Plein Street, Wanderers Street, Noord Street, Taxi Rank and Back.

- 1.2 **Taxi Ranks**

- 1.2.1 **Park City Taxi Rank** situated at the corner of Noord Street and Wanderers Street, **Terminal No. 1 Bays no 7.**

- 1.2.2 **Brakpan Station Taxi Rank** situated at Station Street at **Bay No. 3.**

2. Regulations 1 may be withdrawn earlier by a notice in the Government Gazette in a case of reports and information received indicating that the security situation of participants in the taxi industry as well as passengers in the above area has been normalized. In this regard reports in respect of the progress to reach an agreement between the various participants in the taxi industry, supported by satisfactory supporting mechanisms to ensure that discipline in the industry can practically be enforced, will be taken into account when the normality / abnormality of the situation and the question whether regulation is still necessary as assessed by the MEC for Public Transport, Roads and Works (Gauteng Provincial Government) on a daily basis.
