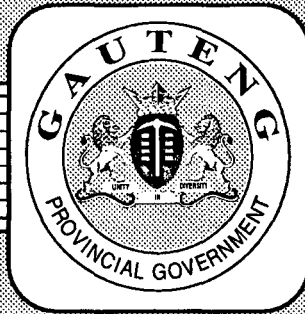

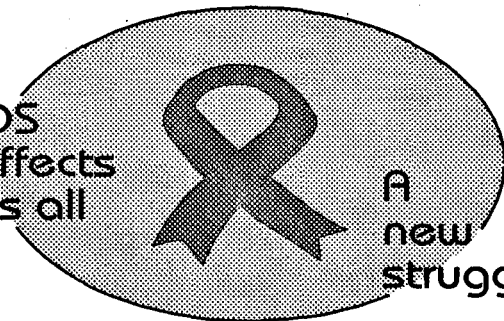

NOTICE 2828 OF 2003

Notice is hereby given that *Provincial Gazette Extraordinary* No. 356 published on 1 September 2003 is hereby withdrawn and superseded by the following:

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT, ROADS AND WORKS

GAUTENG PUBLIC PASSENGER ROAD TRANSPORT ACT (ACT NO.7 OF 2001)

APPLICATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES IN THE AREA OF JURISDICTION OF THE GREATER EAST RAND (EKURHULENI) METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY.

I, **Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng**, being of the opinion that it is necessary to normalize the situation in the area caused by violence, unrest and instability in the mini-bus taxi industry, and that it is in the interests of passengers, hereby declare the area of jurisdiction of the Greater East Rand (Ekurhuleni), Metropolitan Municipality in terms of section 93(2) of the Gauteng Public Passenger Road Transport Act, 2001 (Act No. 7 of 2001) to be an area where the special measures provided for in section 93 will be applicable.

SCHEDULE

1. The following routes and ranks are closed for minibus taxi-type service for a period commencing at **00h01 on Thursday, 4th September 2003 to 00h01 17th September 2003.**

1.1.1 GE0355 Brakpan to Germiston described as follows; Station Road, Voortrekkers Street, Hendrick Potgieter straight Airport Road, Leeuwkop Road, M46, Boksburg Road, Railway street, in Germiston, Plantation Street into Germiston Station Taxi Rank and return.

1.1.2 GE0356 Brakpan to Johannesburg described as follows; Alberton Rd, Heidelberg Rd, N17 off ramp, Pretoria Rd, M2, Harrow Road, Anderson Street, Troye Street, Commissioner street, Von Weileigh Street, Klein Street, Plein Street, Wanderes street, offload cnr Wanderes & Noord Street and return. Vice Versa

1.1.3 GE0364 Brakpan to BENONI described as follows; Station Road, M56, New in Fontein Road, R23, Rangeview Road, Lancaster Road, Dagenham Street, Bolton, Luton into Benoni Station Taxi Rank and return.

1.1.4 GE0365 Brakpan to Springs described as follows; From Tsakane Township and Geluksdal Ext, Heidelberg Road via Dalpark Ext.1 via Carnival City via Minnebron via Dalpark Ext.6, New Kleinfontein Rd via Leachville, Station Road into Brakpan Station Taxi Rank and return.

1.2 RANKS

1.2.1 Johannesburg Taxi Rank inside Brakpan main Taxi Rank
Situating at the corner of Station Road and Victoria Street

2. No person may be undertaken mini-bus taxi-type services on the routes and ranks as specified in regulation 1 during the indicated period. Any person who does so will commit an offence and will; be liable for conviction to imprisonment for a period not exceeding **six months** or a fine not exceeding **R10 000**, or **both a fine and imprisonment.**

3. Regulations 1 and 2 may be withdrawn earlier by a notice in the Government Gazette in a case of reports and information received indicating that the security situation of participants in the taxi industry as well as passengers in the above area has been normalized. In this regard reports in respect of the progress to reach an agreement between the various participants in the taxi industry, supported by satisfactory supporting mechanisms to ensure that discipline in the industry can practically be enforced, will be taken into account when the normality / abnormality of the situation and the question whether regulation is still necessary as assessed by the MEC for Public Transport, Roads and Works (Gauteng Provincial Government) on a daily basis.

4. The Gauteng Provincial Permit Board is hereby authorized to issue temporary permits on application of the Chief Director Transportation Management (Gauteng Department of Public Transport and works) to operators of motor vehicles with a carrying capacity of more than 16 persons, including the driver, to operate on the closed routes for the period as specified in regulation 1 or a part thereof. These permits will automatically terminate when regulation 1 and 2 are withdrawn.
