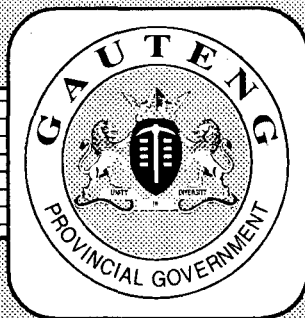

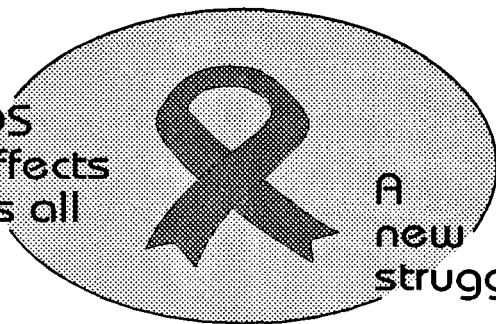

NOTICE 3024 OF 2003

**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT, ROADS AND WORKS**

**GAUTENG PUBLIC PASSENGER ROAD TRANSPORT ACT (ACT NO.7 OF 2001)**

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS TO CLOSE TAXI ROUTES AND RANKS IN TERMS OF SECTION 93(2) OF THE ACT IN THE OF JURISDICTION OF THE GREATER EAST RAND (EKURHULENI) METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY.**

I, Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng, having already declared the area of the **Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality** as an area where it is, in my opinion necessary to normalise the situation in the area caused by violence, unrest and instability in the Mini-Bus taxi industry and that it is in the interest of the passengers as the situation is still abnormal, the closure of routes and ranks as mentioned hereinafter is in my opinion absolutely necessary to normalise the situation. I now give notice of my intention to make regulation in terms of section 93 (2) of the Act to close the routes and ranks as fully described in the schedules hereto. **The regulations will be in force for a period fourteen days from the date of promulgation thereof.**

Any person who wishes to **request reasons** in respect of my intended action should do so in writing. Such request for reasons should be sent by fax to No. **(011) 355 7509**. Such request for reasons should **be made on or before 12h00 on Wednesday, 18 September 2003.**

Any person who wishes to make representations in respect of my intended action should do so in writing. Such representations should be sent by fax to No. **(011) 355 7509**. Such representations should **be made on or before 18h00 on Thursday, 19 September 2003.**

**SCHEDULE**

**1.** The following routes and ranks will be closed for minibus taxi-type.

- 1.1.1** **GE0355 Brakpan to Germiston** described as follows; Station Road, Voortrekkers Street, Hendrick Potgieter straight Airport Road, Leeuwkop Road, M46, Boksburg Road, Railway street, In Germiston, Plantation Street into Germiston Station Taxi Rank and return.
- 1.1.2** **GE0356 Brakpan to Johannesburg** described as follows; Alberton Rd, Heidelberg Rd, N17 off ramp, Pretoria Rd, M2, Harrow Road, Anderson Street, Troye Street, Commissioner street, Von Weileigh Street, Klein Street, Plein Street, Wanderes street, offload cnr Wanderes & Noord Street and return. Vice Versa
- 1.1.3** **GE0364 Brakpan to BENONI** described as follows; Station Road, M56, New In Fontein Road, R23, Rangeview Road, Lancaster Road, Dagenham Street, Bolton, Luton into Benoni Station Taxi Rank and return.
- 1.1.4** **GE0365 Brakpan to Springs** described as follows; From Brakpan Station Taxi Rank to Springs Taxi rank and return.

**1.2** **RANKS**


- 1.2.1** **Johannesburg Taxi Rank inside Brakpan main Taxi Rank**  
Situated at the corner of Station Road and Victoria Street

- 2.** Regulation 1 may be withdrawn earlier by a notice in the Government Gazette in a case of reports and information received indicating that the security situation of participants in the taxi industry as well as passengers in the above area has been normalized. In this regard reports in respect of the progress to reach an agreement between the various participants in the taxi industry, supported by satisfactory supporting mechanisms to ensure that discipline in the industry can practically be enforced, will be taken into account when the normality / abnormality of the situation and the question whether regulation is still necessary as assessed by the MEC for Public Transport, Roads and Works (Gauteng Provincial Government) on a daily basis.
