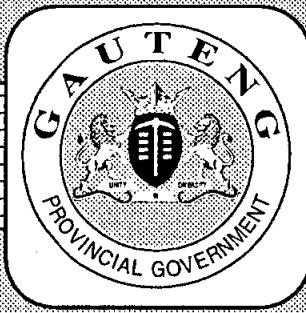

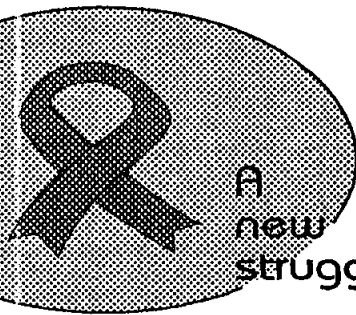

NOTICE 686 OF 2006

CITY OF JOHANNESBURG

Notice of intent for the Security Access Restriction of streets/roads/avenues for security reasons pending approval by the City of Johannesburg (notice in terms of Chapter 7 of the Rationalisation of Local Government Affairs Act, 1998).

Notice is hereby given that the City of Johannesburg, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 7 of the Rationalisation of Local Government Affairs Act, 1998, has considered and approved the following Security Access Restrictions and thereto authorised the Johannesburg Roads Agency to give effect to the said approval and further manage the process and resultant administrative processes of the approval.

SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS APPROVED:

Suburb	Applicant	App. Ref.	Road Name	Type and Restriction Relaxation Hours
Buccleuch	Denise Road Closure	315	Denise Road (South)	A 24-hour manned boom on Denise Road (South), 17m from the through kerb-line of Helen Road.
Buccleuch	Denise Road Closure	315	Denise Road (North)	One palisade closure on Denise Road (North), off the park that lies to the north of the SARA, with a pedestrian gate.
Hyde Park	Morsim Road Closure	293	Morsim Road	A 24-hour manned boom gate on Morsim Road approximately 58m from the nearest kerb-line at the intersection of Morsim Road and 6th Street.
Hyde Park	Morsim Road Closure	293	Curzon Street	A temporary closed palisade gate on Curzon Street approximately 15m from the nearest kerb-line at the intersection of Curzon Street and 1st Avenue.
Hyde Park	Morsim Road Closure	293	Rulin Street	A temporary closed palisade gate on Rulin Street approximately 5m from the nearest kerb-line at the intersection of Rulin Street and Curzon Street.
Hyde Park	9th Road Hyde Park	129	19th Road	A 24-hour manned boom on 9th Road at its intersection with Killarney Road.
Hyde Park	9th Road Hyde Park	129	2nd Road	A palisade gate/fence with pedestrian access on 2nd Road at its intersection with 3rd Road.
Hyde Park	9th Road Hyde Park	129	9th Road	A palisade gate/fence with pedestrian access on 9th Road at its intersection with 3rd Road.
Oaklands	Meyerpark and Stella Street Road Closure Association	113	Stella Street	A boom gate on Stella Street.
Oaklands	Meyerpark and Stella Street Road Closure Association	113	Park Street (North)	A palisade gate with pedestrian access closure at Park Street (North).
Oaklands	Meyerpark and Stella Street Road Closure Association	113	Park Street (South)	A palisade gate with pedestrian access closure at Park Street (South).
Oaklands	Meyerpark and Stella Street Road Closure Association	113	Meyer Street	A palisade gate with pedestrian access closure at Meyer Street.

The restriction will officially come into operation two months from the date of display in the Gauteng Provincial Gazette and will be valid for 2 years.

Further particulars relating to the application as well as a plan indicating the proposed closure may be inspected during normal office hours at the JRA (Pty) Ltd offices, at the address below.

The public is duly advised that, in terms of the City policy relating to these restrictions: ● No person/guard is permitted to deny any other person or vehicle access to or through any roads that are subjects of this approval ● No person or guard is entitled to request or demand proof of identification or to sign any register as a condition of access to an area ● All pedestrian gates should be left accessible (and not locked in any way) 24/7 ● Any violation of the conditions of approval (as detailed in the approval documents) for the permit will result in the restriction permit being revoked.

Any person who has any comments on the conditions of approval in terms of the aforesaid restriction/s, may lodge such comments in writing with the JRA 30 days from the date of publication in the Provincial Gazette.
