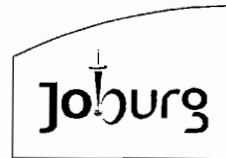

### REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR THE:

- 1) **Amendment to Public Roads and Miscellaneous By-laws to prohibit display of household clothes other than items for sale**
- 2) **Amendment to the Emergency Services By-law**
- 3) **Review of the Public Health By-laws**

The public is invited to submit written comments on the amendments to the by-laws listed above.

#### Prohibition on Display of Household Clothes and other than items for sale

The By-laws to prohibit the display of household clothes other than items for sale are to increase the visual appearance of the City of Joburg and to decrease any hazards that might occur.

#### Amendment to the Emergency Services By-Laws

The Emergency Services By-law is aimed at the regulation of transporting hazardous materials in the City of Joburg. It revolves around the issuing of transport permits being issued by the Fire Chief in order for the transportation of hazardous materials to be permitted.

#### Public Health By-Laws

The proposed changes to the Public Health By-laws are mainly around the enclosure of second hand goods for sale and presence of birds and animals at places which provide child care services.
