NOTICE 3266 OF 2011

ACCEPTANCE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AMENDED PRELIMINARY DESIGN OF ROAD K113 BETWEEN ROADS D51 (K58) AND P91-1 (K155): MODDERFONTEIN/EDENVALE AREA

In terms of section 8(7) of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act No 8 of 2001) ("the Act") it is hereby notified for general information that the Member of the Executive Council for the Gauteng Province ("the MEC") for the Department of Roads and Transport has considered and accepted the amended Preliminary Design for road K113 between roads D51 (K58) and P91-1 (K155) for implementation. The acceptance concerns those sections of the road published for public comments in Notice 1760 of 2011, Provincial Gazette Extraordinary, 136 of 28 June 2011.

It should further be noted that the regulatory measures provided for in section 7 of the Act in respect of the route cease to apply from the date of this notice to the extent of the route along or over which the preliminary design was accepted by the MEC in terms of the section 8(7) of the Act and that the regulatory measures contained in section 9 of the aforementioned Act apply with relation to the accepted preliminary design from the date of this notice.

In terms of regulation 8 of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Regulations, 2002, interested and affected parties are hereby notified in accordance with regulation 24(2) of the aforementioned Regulations that they may request reasons for the acceptance of the aforementioned preliminary design within 21 days after the date of this notice at the following address: Head: Department of, Roads and Transport, Private Bag X83, Marshalltown, 2017, for attention: Director: Design, quoting reference number 2/1/1/2/3/1-K113.

In terms of section 8(7) (b) of the Act notice is hereby given that the preliminary design in question is reflected on key plan GRP 09/06/1 PKp and layout plans GRP 09/06/1-6 Ply which are available for inspection by any interested person, at the Plan Room of the Department of Roads and Transport, First Floor, South Tower, Sage Life Building, 41 Simmonds Street, Johannesburg.
