REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR THE AMENDMENT TO PUBLIC ROADS AND MISCELLANEOUS BY-LAWS RELATING TO PARKING METERS

The public is invited to submit written comments on the amendments to the by-laws listed above. The amendment to the By-laws will give effect to the Council's policy to regulate parking along the kerbside in the City

The By-law relating to Parking Meters are to ensure that motorists get equal rights to park on the allocated bays, as these are taken up by businesses and/or taxis in the city, who already have allocated spaces available. These parking bays would be managed under a time limit by a parking marshal.

The purpose of the amendment to the by-law is to provide for handheld parking meters that are linked to a central computer on which all transactions will be registered. The proposed amendment provides for:

- (a) Parking meter Marshalls who will issue parking meter coupon via handed computers;
- (b) Parking meter is inclusive of cash card facilities
- (c) Parking coupons that will display the registration number and the permissible parking period that the driver has paid for; and
- (d) The clamping of wheels of vehicles that are illegally parked.
