

PROPOSED DETERMINATION OF A BUS RAPID TRANSIT ROUTE AND STATIONS: LINE 2B FROM THE INTERSECTION OF UNIVERSITY — AND LYNNWOOD ROAD EASTBOUND ALONG LYNNWOOD ROAD AND RIGHT INTO ATTERBURY ROAD UP TO THE INTERSECTION WITH LOIS STREET AND A BUS TURNING LOOP ALONG ATTERBURY ROAD RIGHT INTO JANUARY MASILELA DRIVE, RIGHT INTO ARAMIST AVENUE, RIGHT INTO LOIS STREET AND BACK TO ATTERBURY ROAD AS WELL AS 6 (SIX) FIXED STATION LOCATIONS.

Notice is hereby given, in terms of section 65*bis* (2) of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939, that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality intends to:

- Determine a bus rapid transit route, being the Line 2B route from the intersection of University Road and Lynnwood Road eastbound until it turns right into Atterbury Road onwards to the intersection with Lois Street and a bus turning loop along Atterbury Road southbound into January Masilela Drive, westbound into Aramist Avenue, northbound up to Lois Street and back to Atterbury Road in Menlyn, linking Hatfield with Menlyn;
- Determine 6 (six) fixed median station locations along the route as indicated below:
