

PROPOSED DETERMINATION OF A TSHWANE RAPID TRANSIT (TRT) BUS FEEDER NETWORK ROUTE AND THE TRT FEEDER BUS STOPS FOR THE INCEPTION PHASE OF THE TRT BETWEEN THE PRETORIA CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CBD) AND HATFIELD STATION

Notice is hereby given, in terms of section 65*bis* (2) of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939, read with sections 21 and 21A of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality intends to:

- Determine a Tshwane Rapid Transit feeder network route from the Central Business District (CBD) to Hatfield, covering the areas of Sunnyside, Arcadia, Muckleneuk, Groenkloof and Pretoria West; and
- Determine approximately 32 feeder bus stops along the route as indicated below:

Sunnyside / Arcadia

Route: In Malan Street to the south of Steve Biko Hospital, into Johan Heyns Street to Soutpansberg Street. Along Hamilton Street to Troye Street, along Kotze Street to Nelson Mandela Drive to the T-junction at Edmund Street to Steve Biko Street, to Dr Savage Road, Johan Heyns Drive and back to Malan Street.

- Stop 1 On Johan Heyns Street between Malan and Rose Streets
- Stop 2 On Johan Heyns Steet between Rose and Annie Botha Streets
- Stop 3 On Hamilton Street between Edmond and Ziervogel Streets
- Stop 4 On Hamilton Street between Pretorius and Francis Baard Streets
- Stop 5 On Kotze Street between Troye and Jubilee Streets
- Stop 6 On Kotze Street between Steve Biko and Joubert Streets
- Stop 7 On Nelson Mandela Drive between Madiba and Johannes Ramokhoase Streets
- Stop 8 On Steve Biko Street between Belvedere and Soutpansberg Streets
- Stop 9 On Steve Biko Street between Soutpansberg and Dr Savage Streets
- Stop 10 On Bophelo Street between Dr Savage and Malan Streets

Muckleneuk

Route: In Kotze Street to Justice Mahomed Street, to Mears Street into Elandspoort Street past UNISA to Nelson Mandela Drive. Take the slipway left to George Storrar Drive up to Leyds Street, continue to Bourke Street, to Kotze Street and continue to Troye Street.

- Stop 1 On Kotze Street between Leyds and Celliers Streets
- Stop 2 On Kotze Street between Celliers and Troye Streets
- Stop 3 On Troye Street between Jorissen and Rissik Streets
- Stop 4 On Troye Street between Rissik and Justice Mahomed Streets
- Stop 5 On Justice Mahomed Street between Troye and Mears Streets
- Stop 6 On Mears Street between Justice Mahomed and Ridge Streets
- Stop 7 On Elandspoort Street between Justice Mahomed and Ridge Streets
- Stop 8 On Elandspoort north of UNISA Campus (Close proximity to University and a residential area);
- Stop 9 On Leyds Street between the University of Pretoria Groenkloof Campus and Sibeliu Street
- Stop 10 On Bourke Street between Ridge and Berea Streets
- Stop 11 On Bourke Street between Reitz and Jorissen Streets
- Stop 12 On Bourke Street between Jorissen and Kotze Street

Pretoria West

Route: Start at the Tshwane University of Technology and Staatsartillerie junction to Rebecca Street, to Soutter Street across E'skia Mphahlele Drive to Francis Baard Street. Continue to Lilian Ngoyi Street along Nana Sita Street to Mitchell Street and back to Rebecca Street.

- **Stop 1 -** On Morkel Street East where Soshanguve buses stop and use turnaround facility on school property;
- Stop 2 On Rebecca Street between Nic van Vuuren and Vom Hagen Street
- Stop 3 On Soutter Street between Zeiler and Schutte Streets
- Stop 4 On Soutter Street between Ketjen and President Burger Streets
- Stop 5 On Soutter Street between Retief and Von Wielligh Street
- Stop 6 On Francis Baard Street between Kgosi Mampuru and Sophie de Bruyn Streets
- Stop 7 On Francis Baard Street between Bosman and Paul Kruger Street
- Stop 8 On Nana Sita Street between Thabo Sehume and Paul Kruger Streets
- Stop 9 On Nana Sita Street between Paul Kruger and Bosman Streets
- Stop 10 On Nana Sita Street between Sophie de Bruyn and Kgosi Mampuru Streets

Full particulars of the proposed route and station locations, plans and reports, will lay for inspection during normal office hours for a period of 21 (Twenty One) days until 29 November 2013 at the office of the IRPT Specialized Unit, First floor, Room 101, Infotech Building, 1090 Arcadia Street, Hatfield (Attention: Mr Clifford Malimabe, Tel: (012) 358 6269, Fax: 086 2604059, E-mail: cliffordma@tshwane.gov.za). Any objections to or presentations in respect of the proposed route and station determinations must be lodged with the Project Work Stream Leader at the above address in writing by not later than 29 November 2013. All objections and presentations received shall be considered to establish the validity thereof as well as any reasonable mitigating factors that may be introduced to address the objections and presentations received where after the unresolved objections and presentation shall be referred to the Mayoral Committee for a final decision. Should no objections be received, the City shall be entitled to proceed with the implementation of the proposed feeder route and stations on 29 November 2013.
