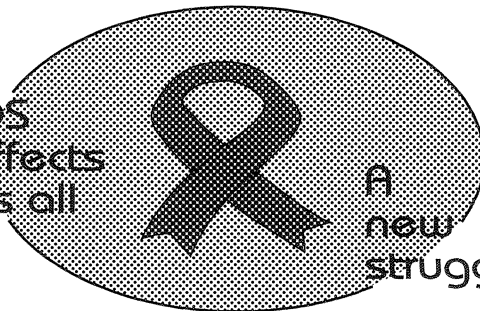

## LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE 227

### PROPOSED PERMANENT CLOSING OF PORTIONS OF PAUL KRUGER STREET BETWEEN PRETORIA STATION AND BOOM STREET FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF TRAFFIC

Notice is hereby given, in terms of section 66 of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939, that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality (the City) intends to permanently close portions of Paul Kruger Street between Pretoria Station and Boom Street for certain classes of traffic to facilitate the implementation of its bus rapid transit system. A summary of the proposed street closures is detailed in Table 1 below:

<p><b><u>Zone 3- Church Square (Pretorius Street to Madiba Street)</u></b></p> <p>To be closed for all classes of vehicle traffic, except:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• City of Tshwane Rapid Transit (TRT) buses; and</li> <li>• Cyclists</li> <li>• Pedestrian</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Zone 4- Madiba Street to Boom Street</u></b></p> <p>To be closed for all classes of vehicle traffic, except:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Property owners, employees and visitors, as well as delivery services;</li> <li>• Cyclists;</li> <li>• Emergency vehicles to access Paul Kruger; and</li> <li>• City of Tshwane Rapid Transit (TRT) buses</li> <li>• Pedestrian</li> </ul>

Further particulars of the proposed street closures will lay for inspection during normal office hours for a period of 21 (twenty one) days until **22 March 2013** at the office of the Project Work Stream Leader: IRPT/BRT Infrastructure Implementation, First floor, Room 101, Infotech Building, 1090 Arcadia Street, Hatfield (Attention: Mr Clifford Malimabe, Tel: (012) 358-6379, Fax: 086 260 4059, E-mail: cliffordma@tshwane.gov.za).

Any objections to or presentations in respect of the proposed street closures must be lodged with the Project Work Stream Leader at the above address in writing by not later than **22 March 2013**. All objections and presentations received shall be considered to establish the validity thereof as well as any reasonable mitigating factors that may be introduced to address the objections and presentations received, whereafter the unresolved objections and presentation shall be referred to the Mayoral Committee for a final decision. Should no objections be received, the City shall be entitled to proceed with the implementation of the proposed street closures on **23 March 2013**.

Notice No 578 of 2012 (Proposed Permanent Closing of a portion of Paul Kruger Street between Pretoria Station and Boom Street for Certain Classes of Traffic) is herewith withdrawn.
