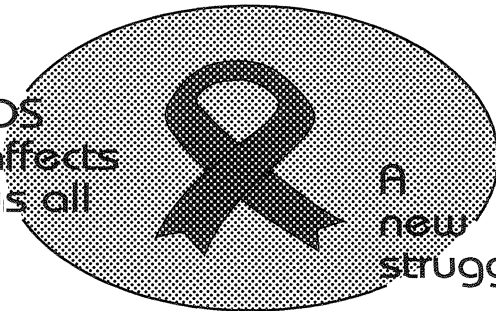

NOTICE TO MERGE AND CLOSE SCHOOLS IN THE GAUTENG WEST DISTRICT

1. By virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of Sections 12A and 33 of the South African Schools Act (Act 84 of 1996) I, Barbara Creecy, the Member of the Executive Council responsible for Education, hereby officially gazette merger and closure of schools listed in 3 below.

2. Reason for closure
 - The school offered multi – grade teaching, which was counter productive for effective teaching and learning.
 - The learner population has decreased drastically.
 - Due to natural attrition schools were merged and closed to maximise the use of available state resources.
