GENERAL NOTICE

NOTICE 2806 OF 2014

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE GAUTENG LIQUOR BOARD IN TERMS OF SECTION 4 OF THE GAUTENG LIQUOR ACT, ACT NO. 2 OF 2003.

- I. The Member of the Executive Council responsible for Economic Development in Gauteng Province hereby calls for nominations of candidates to serve on the Gauteng Liquor Board;
- II. All interested persons are hereby invited to submit their written nominations for appointment as members of Gauteng Liquor Board;
- III. The Board shall consist of no less than six (6) and not more than nine (9) members;
- IV. Members of the Gauteng Liquor Board are appointed by the responsible Member of Executive Council as follows:
 - (a) one or more persons admitted as Attorney or Advocate with at least five years' experience in the legal profession or administration of justice;
 - (b) one or more representatives of the Department responsible for the administration of the Act;
 - (c) one or more persons appointed by reason of his or her knowledge in the field of welfare or socio- economic development or social services; and
 - (d) one or more persons appointed by reason of his or her knowledge or experience in the liquor industry and not actively involved therein nor having a financial interest; whether direct or indirect.
- V. No person shall be appointed a member of the Board if such person:
 - a) is not a citizen of the Republic resident in the Province;
 - b) is an un-rehabilitated insolvent;
 - c) is subject to an order of court declaring such person to be mentally ill or disordered;
 - d) has at any time been convicted; whether in the Republic or elsewhere of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering of a forged document, perjury, an offence under this Act or the Corruption Act, Act No 94 of 1992 or any offence involving dishonesty;
 - e) has at any time been removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct; or
 - f) has a direct or indirect financial interest in the liquor business or is a spouse of such a person.
- VI. The nomination must include the following information:
 - a) the full names of the nominee;
 - b) motivation for the nominee;
 - c) a certified copy of the nominee's identity document;
 - d) certified copies of the nominee's qualification/s;
 - e) comprehensive CV of the nominee; and
 - f) a letter of consent from the nominee to serve as a Board member.
- VII. A person may nominate himself or herself.

The closing date for the nominations is **11 September 2014**.

Applications of nominees received after the closing date will not be considered.
