INFORMATION STATEMENT IN TERMS OF SECTION 33(1)(a)(i)(aa) AND (bb) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL FINANCE MANAGEMENT ACT 56 OF 2003 RELATING TO THE LONG-TERM BUS AUTOMATED FARE COLLECTION CONTRACT THAT THE CITY OF TSHWANE INTENDS TO CONCLUDE IN RESPECT OF ITS A RE YENG PROJECT

In terms of section 33(1)(a)(i)(aa) and (bb) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003, read with section 21A of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, the City of Tshwane hereby publishes the following Information Statement summarising the City's obligations in terms of the draft automated fare collection long term contract ("the Contract") which the City intends to enter into in respect of Phase 1 of its A Re Yeng Project ("the Project"):

INFORMATION STATEMENT

AUTOMATED FARE COLLECTION CONTRACT

1. PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT

To provide an EMV based automated fare collection service in respect of Phase 1 of the A Re Yeng Project. The automated fare collection contractor will be responsible for the design, build, installation the operation and maintenance for a period of 12 years of an Automated Fare Collection System for the Tshwane Rapid Transit and Tshwane Bus Services. The Contractor will provide a turnkey solution and will be paid for this service on a monthly basis.

The Contract will be performance based, with performance to be measured on a monthly basis in accordance with Key Performance Indicators, stipulated in the Contract.

2. PROPOSED TERM OF THE CONTRACT

A maximum period of 12 years.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE CONTRACT

The total contract amount pertaining to the automated fare collection contract amounts to R1 415 801 461,00 (one-billion four-hundred-and-fifteen-million, eight-hundred-and-one thousand, four-hundred-and-sixty-one Rand) including VAT over a twelve year period.

The costs for the design, build and implementation are to be partially funded from the Public Transport Infrastructure System (PTIS) Fund, the Public Transport Network Operations Grant fund (PTNOG) and partially from the Fare Revenue, City funding and other revenue sources. The operational cost is also to be funded from the Fare Revenue.
