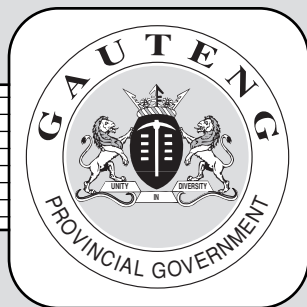

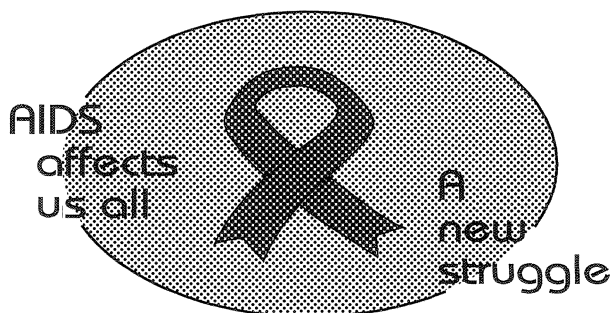


LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL DEMARCATION ACT, 1998

NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 23(3)(b)

I Jacob Mamabolo, Member of the Executive Council responsible for local government in the Province of Gauteng, under section 23(3)(b) of the Local Government: Municipal Demarcation Act, 1998 (Act No. 27 of 1998,) hereby confirm the view expressed by the Municipal Demarcation Board in terms of section 21(5)(c) of the Local Government: Municipal Demarcation Act. The boundary redetermination of the municipalities referred to in Schedule 1 will not materially affect the representation of voters in such councils of the municipalities. Implementation date of the boundary changes will coincide with the date of the local government elections in 2016.
