GENERAL NOTICE**NOTICE 4003 OF 2014****GAUTENG GAMBLING AND BETTING ACT, 1995.****APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER AND AMENDMENT OF A SITE OPERATOR LICENCE AS CONTEMPLATED IN SECTIONS 34 AND 35 OF THE GAUTENG GAMBLING BOARD ACT, 1995, AS AMENDED.**

Notice is hereby given that Bora Bora Courier and Bike Hire CC, Stand 1281, shop 15 a/b, 15 Emerald Street, Carletonville Extension 2, in the district of Oberholzer, intend submitting an application to the Gauteng Gambling Board for transfer of a gaming machine licence held by Niko Harito t/a Chicago Bar & Restaurant, Shop 2 emerald street, Carletonville to Bora Bora Courier and Bike Hire CC t/a Chicago Bar & Restaurant and for the amendment of its site Operator Licence to increase the number of Limited Payout Machines (LPMs) from three (3) to five (5) as contemplated in Sections 34 and 35 of the Gauteng Gambling Act, 1995, as amended.

The application will be open to public inspection at the offices of the Board, 125 Corlett Drive, Bramley, Johannesburg, from 24th November 2014.

Attention is directed to the provisions of Section 20 of the Gauteng Gambling Act 1995 which makes provision for the lodging of written representations in respect of the application.

Such representations should be lodged with the Chief Executive officer, Gauteng Gambling Board, Private Bag 15, Bramley, 2018 within one month from 24th November 2014.

Any person submitting representations should state in such representation whether or not they wish to make oral representations at the hearing of the application.
