NOTICE 1415 OF 2015

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE GAUTENG GAMBLING BOARD

- I. The Member of the Executive Council responsible for Economic Development in Gauteng Province hereby calls for nominations in terms of Section 5 of the Gauteng Gambling Act, Act No.4 of 1995, as amended of candidates to serve on the Gauteng Gambling Board.
- II. All interested persons are hereby invited to submit their written nominations for appointment as members of Gauteng Gambling Board;
- III. Members of the Gauteng Gambling Board are appointed by the responsible Member of Executive Council;
- IV. The Board shall consist of between eight (8) and twelve (12) members who shall be fit and proper persons, appointed by the responsible Member, and whom-
- two shall be practicing attorneys or advocates with experience as such of not less than five(5) years;
 - one shall be an accountant and auditor registered in terms of section 15 of the Public Accountants' and Auditors' Act, 1991 (Act No. 80 of 1991), with experience in public practice as defined in section 1 of that Act of not less than five (5) years;
 - one shall be appointed by virtue of his/her knowledge and active involvement in the tourism industry;
 - one shall be appointed by reason of his/her knowledge and experience in the field of welfare or of community or socio-economic development;
 - one shall be appointed by reason of his/her knowledge and experience in the field of labour relations; and
 - between two (2) and six (6) persons who shall either have proven business acumen, a knowledge of the gambling or horse-racing industry or technology relevant to gambling, or who are otherwise suitable for appointment as members of the board: Provided that, for a period of two (2) years after commencement of this Act, one of such persons shall have knowledge of the horse-racing or the horse-racing betting industry, and one shall if possible have knowledge of the gambling industry.
- V. No person shall be appointed or remain a member of the Board if he or she:
- is not a citizen of the Republic resident in the Province;
 - at the relevant time is, or during the preceding twelve months was, a public servant;
 - at the relevant time is, or during the preceding twelve months was, a member of Parliament, any provincial legislature or local authority, or any council, commission or house of traditional leaders established in terms of the Constitution;
 - at the relevant time is, or during the preceding twelve months was, an office-bearer or employee of any party, movement, organisation or body of a party political nature;
 - has a controlling interest or any financial or other interest in any gambling activity;
 - or his or her partner or associate, holds an office in or with, or is employed by, any person, company, organisation or other body, whether corporate or unincorporate, which has an interest contemplated in paragraph (e);
 - is an unrehabilitated insolvent;
 - is of unsound mind, or is subject to an order of a competent court declaring such person to be mentally ill or disordered;
 - has at any time been convicted, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering a forged document, perjury, an offence under this Act or the Corruption Act, 1992 (Act No. 94 of 1992), or any offence involving dishonesty, and has been sentenced therefore to imprisonment without the option of a fine or to a fine exceeding R100;
 - has at any time been removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct;
 - is a member of the family of a person contemplated in paragraph (b), (c), (d), (e) or (f) if, in the opinion of the responsible Member in concurrence with the Standing Committee on Finance and Economic Affairs, such family relationship may give rise to a real or perceived conflict of interest; or
 - failed to disclose an interest in terms of section 7(2)(a), or attended or participated in the proceedings of the board while having an interest contemplated in section 7(1).
- VI. The nomination must include the following information:
- The full names of the nominee;
 - Motivation for the nominee;
 - A certified copy of the nominee's identity document;
 - Certified copies of the nominee's qualification/s;
 - Comprehensive CV of the nominee; and
 - A letter of consent from the nominee to serve as a Board member;
- VII. A person may nominate himself or herself.

The closing date for the nominations is **27 May 2015**.

Applications of nominees received after the closing date will not be considered.
