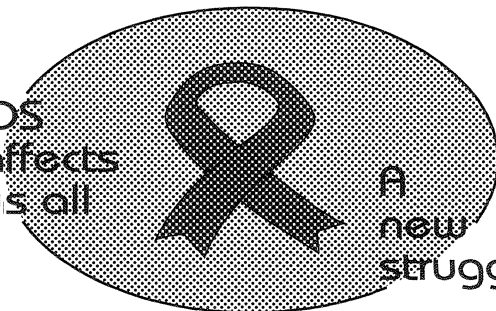

Government Printing Works has implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submits your notice request.

Please take note of these guidelines when completing your form.



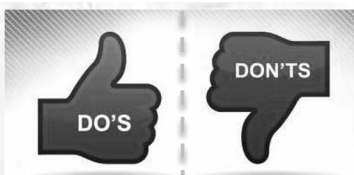
GPW Business Rules

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.
2. Notices can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format to the email submission address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted to this mailbox will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines – www.gpwonline.co.za)
7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email info.egazette@gpw.gov.za)
8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday, 18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.

Furthermore, the fax number **012- 748 6030** will also be **discontinued** from this date and customers will only be able to submit notice requests through the email address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za.





DO use the new Adobe Forms for your notice request. These new forms can be found on our website: www.gpwonline.co.za under the Gazette Services page.

DO attach documents separately in your email to GPW. (In other words, your email should have an Adobe Form plus proof of payment – 2 separate attachments – where notice content is applicable, it should also be a 3rd separate attachment)

DO specify your requested publication date.

DO send us the electronic Adobe form. (There is no need to print and scan it).

DON'T submit request as a single PDF containing all other documents, i.e. form, proof of payment & notice content, it will be **FAILED** by our new system.

DON'T print and scan the electronic Adobe form.

DON'T send queries or RFQ's to the submit.egazette mailbox.

DON'T send bad quality documents to GPW. (Check that documents are clear and can be read)



Form Completion Rules

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


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in terms of the provisions section 75A of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 [Act No. 32 of 2000], that the Randfontein Local Municipality at its Special meeting held on 27 May 2015 resolved to amend its Water Supply Tariffs with effect from 01 July 2015, as follows:

The present Water Supply Tariffs, published under Local Authority Notice no 872, as promulgated in the Provincial Gazette, Extraordinary no 172, dated 01 July 2014, are hereby forthwith substituted by the following:

"1. Water Supply Tariffs

- (i) 0-6 kl @ R5,13 - Rand Water cost
6,01 kl – 15 kl = R 18-22
15,01 kl – 30 kl = R 20-30
30,01 kl and above = R 22-18;
- (ii) that the 6kl free basic water be accorded Indigent Households only;
- (iii) that the basic charges for water be levied on undeveloped stands as follows:
 - Residential – 22,96c
 - Business – 22,96c
 - Industrial stands – 22,96c;
- (iv) that the tariff for business and industrial consumers be as follows :
 - 0 – 100 kl = R 19-42 per kl
 - and above 101 kl = R 18-59 per kl
- (v) that consumers other than business, residential and industry (e.g. churches and schools) pay a tariff of R 16-45 per kl"

2. Any other Water Supply Tariffs published, which are in contradiction with the abovementioned Water Supply Tariffs are herewith revoked with effect from 01 July 2015.



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
