# Notice submission deadlines

Government Printing Works has over the last few months implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submit your notice request.

In line with these business rules, GPW has revised the notice submission deadlines for all gazettes. Please refer to the GPW website <a href="https://www.gpwonline.co.za">www.gpwonline.co.za</a> to familiarise yourself with the new deadlines.

# CANCELLATIONS



Cancellation of notice submissions are accepted by GPW according to the deadlines stated in the table above. Non-compliance to these deadlines will result in your request being failed. Please pay special attention to the different deadlines for each gazette.

Please note that any notices cancelled after the cancellation deadline will be published and charged at full cost.

Requests for cancellation must be sent by the original sender of the notice and must accompanied by the relevant notice reference number (N-) in the email body.

## AMENDMENTS TO NOTICES



With effect from 01 October, GPW will not longer accept amendments to notices. The cancellation process will need to be followed and a new notice submitted thereafter for the next available publication date.

# CUSTOMER INQUIRIES



Many of our customers request immediate feedback/confirmation of notice placement in the gazette from our Contact Centre once they have submitted their notice – While GPW deems it one of their highest priorities and responsibilities to provide customers with this requested feedback and the best service at all times, we are only able to do so once we have started processing your notice submission.

GPW has a **2-working day turnaround time for processing notices** received according to the business rules and deadline submissions.

Please keep this in mind when making inquiries about your notice submission at the Contact Centre.

# PROOF OF PAYMENTS REMINDER

GPW reminds you that all notice submissions **MUST** be submitted with an accompanying proof of payment (PoP) or purchase order (PO). If any PoP's or PO's are received without a notice submission, it will be failed and your notice will not be processed.

When submitting your notice request to <a href="mailto:submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za">submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za</a>, please ensure that a purchase order (GPW Account customer) or proof of payment (non-GPW Account customer) is included with your notice submission. All documentation relating to the notice submission must be in a single email.

A reminder that documents must be attached separately in your email to GPW. (In other words, your email should have an Adobe Form plus proof of payment/purchase order – 2 separate attachments – where notice content is applicable, it should also be a 3rd separate attachment).

### REMINDER OF THE GPW BUSINESS RULES

- ☐ Single notice, single email with proof of payment or purchase order.
- All documents must be attached separately in your email to GPW.
- 1 notice = 1 form, i.e. each notice must be on a separate form
- ☐ Please submit your notice **ONLY ONCE.**
- Requests for information, quotations and inquiries must be sent to the Contact Centre ONLY.
- The notice information that you send us on the form is what we publish. Please do not put any instructions in the email body.

#### **AMENDMENT OF PART 2**

Amendment of clause 7

Clause 7 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

- "7. The council of the Sedibeng District Municipality consists of 49 councillors of whom:
  - (a) 20 must be proportionally elected councillors;
  - (b) 23 must be appointed by the local municipality mentioned in Part 3 of this Schedule;
  - (c) 3 must be appointed by the local municipality mentioned in Part 4 of this Schedule; and
  - (d) 3 must be appointed by the local municipality mentioned in Part 5 of this Schedule."

#### **AMENDMENT OF PART 3**

2. Amendment of clause 15

Clause 15 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

- "15. The council of the Emfuleni Local Municipality consists of 90 councillors as determined in provincial General Notice No. 2899 dated 9 October 2015 of whom:
  - (a) 45 must be proportionally elected councillors; and
  - (b) 45 must be ward councillors."
- Amendment of clause 17

Clause 17 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

"17. The Emfuleni Local Municipality consists of 45 wards with boundaries as set out in provincial General Notice No. 557 dated 21 December 2015."

#### AMENDMENT OF PART 4

#### 4. Amendment of clause 24

Clause 24 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

- "24. The council of the Midvaal Local Municipality consists of 29 councillors as determined in provincial General Notice No. 2899 dated 9 October 2015 of whom:
  - (a) 14 must be proportionally elected councillors; and
  - (b) 15 must be ward councillors."

#### Amendment of clause 26

Clause 26 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

"26. The Midvaal Local Municipality consists of 15 wards with boundaries as set out in provincial General Notice No. 556 dated 21 December 2015."

#### **AMENDMENT OF PART 5**

#### Amendment of clause 33

Clause 33 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

- "33. The council of the Lesedi Local Municipality consists of 26 councillors as determined in provincial General Notice No. 2899 dated 9 October 2015 of whom:
  - (a) 13 must be proportionally elected councillors; and
  - (b) 13 must be ward councillors."

#### 7. Amendment of clause 35

Clause 35 is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following clause:

"35. The Lesedi Local Municipality consists of 13 wards with boundaries as set out in provincial General Notice No. 555 dated 21 December 2015."

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
