 - d) one shall be appointed by reason of his/her knowledge and experience in the field of welfare or of community or socioeconomic development;
 - e) one shall be appointed by reason of his/her knowledge and experience in the field of labor relations; and
 - f) between the two (2) and six (6) persons who shall either have proven business acumen, a knowledge of the gambling or horse-racing industry or technology relevant to gambling or who are otherwise suitable for appointment as members of the board: provided that, for a period of two (2) years after commencement of this Act, one of such person shall have knowledge of the horse-racing or the horse-racing betting industry, and one shall if possible have knowledge of the gambling industry.

 - a) is not a citizen of the Republic, and resident in the Province;
 - b) is a Member of Parliament, a Provincial Legislature, a Municipal council or a House of Traditional leaders established in terms of the constitution;
 - c) is an un-rehabilitated insolvent;
 - d) is of unsound mind, as declared by a competent court;
 - e) has at any time been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty;
 - f) has at any time been removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct; and
 - g) has previously been removed from the Board for a breach of any provision of this Act.

VII. A Director of the Board must vacate office if that member becomes subject to a disqualification contemplated in subsection (1).

- VIII. The nomination must include the following information:
 - a) The full names of the nominee;
 - b) Motivation for the nominee;
 - c) A certified copy of the nominee's identity document;
 - d) Certified copies of the nominee's qualification/s;
 - e) Comprehensive CV of the nominee; and
