LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE 1709 OF 2018

Notice of the implementation of mandatory waste separation at source in terms of the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality Waste Management By-Laws

The public is hereby notified of the Council's intention to implement section 22 of the City of Johannesburg Waste Management By-laws. The purpose of this notice is to comply with the section as stated in the Waste Management By-laws, promulgated on 30 July 2013, No 216.

Section 22: Obligation to separate waste into recyclables and non-recyclables

"The Council may prescribe by a notice published in the Provincial Gazette that, from a prescribed date, areas, specific generators or holders of particular categories of waste must for the purpose of recycling, separate those categories of waste and must, store, dispose of or treat the separated waste in the manner prescribed in the notice"

The Council is currently providing the service of source separation of dry recyclables in the areas listed below and has also developed drop off facilities (i.e. garden sites) for the purpose of receiving garden waste and dry recyclables from communities residing within the city.

As such, the Council hereby notifies the generators and holders of dry recyclable waste and garden waste who reside in the areas listed below that effective **1st July 2018** it is compulsory to separate their waste. It is deemed compulsory to separate waste at source for the purpose of waste recovery and recycling, and such waste should be stored separately in appropriate receptacles for collection and disposal at authorized facilities.

For dry recyclables, the Council or duly authorized service providers will continue to provide the appropriate bags or receptacles and collect the dry recyclables on a prescribed collection schedule applicable to each area.

For garden waste, it is the duty of the households to separate, store and transport their own garden waste and dispose of at the nearest drop off facility (i.e. garden site).

Failure to separate waste at source in the affected suburbs shall henceforth be an offence. The separation at source of dry recyclable waste and garden waste affects the wards in the Regions across the City of Johannesburg as outlined below, and shall become mandatory and effective upon publication of this notice in the Gauteng Provincial Gazette on **12 October 2018**:
