NOTICE 921 OF 2019

GAUTENG DEPARTMENT OF ROADS AND TRANSPORT NATIONAL LAND TRANSPORT ACT, 2009 (ACT NO. 5 OF 2009) AMENDMENT OF PUBLISHED NOTICE 454 OF 2019

WHEREAS, Section 91(1) of the National Land Act, 2009 (Act No.5 of 2009) provides for the Member of the Executive Council responsible for public transport to define, by notice in the Provincial Gazette an area characterized by violence, unrest or instability in the public transport sector and declare it to be an area in respect of which extraordinary measures are to be applied, and

WHEREAS, Section 91(8) of the National Land Act, 2009 (Act No.5 of 2009) further provides for the Member of the Executive Council responsible for public transport to amend the notification made in respect of Section 91(1);


NOW THEREFORE, I, Jacob Mamabolo, **Member of the Executive Council for the Gauteng Provincial Government** responsible for Public Transport and Road Infrastructure, hereby amend the Regulations made in terms of Section 91(3) read with other sections of the National Land Transport Act, 2009 (Act No.5 of 2009) published under Notice 454 of 2019. The Regulations are amended after the signing of a joint declaration by Witwatersrand African Taxi Association and the Nancefield Dube West Taxi Association dated 11 June 2019.

The amended Regulations have the following conditions:

1. 200 vehicles (100 Witwatersrand African Taxi Association and 100 Nancefield Dube West Taxi Association) to operate on a 50/50 basis.
2. The Department of Roads and Transport will issue each vehicle 3 stickers with security features. The stickers must be placed each on the windscreen, front panel and back of the vehicle.
3. The sticker on the screen must have the following details:
 - 3.1. Particulars of the Operator (Name, Surname and ID Number).
 - 3.2. Vehicle details (Registration number of the vehicle and colour).
 - 3.3. Operating license number
 - 3.4. Board route codes of the disputed ranks and routes.
4. The Witwatersrand African Taxi Association and the Nancefield Dube West Taxi Association operations to commence on the 18th of June 2019 at 00h01.
5. The routes and ranks shall remain monitored at 00h01 on 16 June 2019 until 16 December 2019 at 00h00.

Short title and commencement

These Regulations are called Amended Gauteng Public Transport Extraordinary Measures, 2019, and come into operation at 00h01 on 16 June 2019.
