RECAPITALISIATION OF COMMUNITY LIBRARIES GRANT **Projected life** Ongoing, the projected life will be informed by evaluation reports. MTEF allocations for transfers 2019/20: R115.038 million; 2020/21: R116.300 million; 2021/22: R121.300 million. The initial allocation to Emfuleni Local Municipality was reduced with R1.762 million. Some library projects will be implemented by the Department on behalf of Emfuleni. Off-set R5 850 722 from Emfuleni and R2 140 335 from Lesedi. The total off set amount of R7 991 057 million was re-allocated to the following municipalities: R2 000 000 for Johannesburg for books, R500,000 for the Sharpeville Library ceiling to Emfuleni, study area extended at Bantu Bonke Modular Library and upgrade at Sicelo Library with total allocation of R1 874 524 to Midvaal. Air conditioners for the Merafong City Libraries allocated R1 500 000 and R2 116 533 for the appointment of staff for the new Randfontein Library to Rand West City. 2019/20 Mid-year adjustment: An additional amount of R5 500 000 allocated to the following municipalities: R1 500 000 for maintenance on the Springs Library (Ekurhuleni Metro); R1 000 000 for Emfuleni for security guards; R1 000 000 for Lesedi for maintenance & books for Kwazenzele; R1 000 000 for Midvaal for the upgrade of De Deur Library; R1 000 000 for Mogale City for maintenance i.e. roof leaking, painting and carpets (Hekpoort), roof leaking ceiling & air reconditioning (Kagiso Extension 12 Library), roof leaking, ceiling & painting (old Kagiso Library), changing doors, windows and carpets (Krugersdorp Library), carpets and doors (Desmond Tutu Library), fence extension and carports (Kagiso and Smoketown Modular Libraries).
