APPLICATION FOR CONSENT FOR PROCUREMENT OF INTEREST IN A LICENSEE

Notice is hereby given that Infiniti Gaming International Sarl located at 60A Rue du Neudorf, L220, Luxembourg, intends to apply to the Gauteng Gambling Board for consent to acquire an additional 14.5% of the shares in Infiniti Gaming Africa (Pty) Ltd located at Building 26, Woodlands Office Park, Woodlands Drive, Woodmead, South Africa, 2191.

Infiniti Gaming Africa (Pty) Ltd is a 100% shareholder of DRGT Africa (Pty) Ltd which operates as a licenced manufacturer, supplier and maintenance provider in terms of section 38(2)(a) of the National Gambling Act 7 of 2004, read with regulation 20 of the National Gambling Regulations, 2004.

5. Whether or not they wish to make oral representations at the hearing of the application.
