### COMING INTO OPERATION: MPUMALANGA LOCAL GOVERNMENT LAWS REPEAL ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 9 OF 2005)

It is hereby notified that I, David Dabede Mabuza, in my capacity as Premier of the Mpumalanga Province, have, in terms of section 4 of the Mpumalanga Local Government Laws Repeal Act, 2005 (Act No. 9 of 2005), determined 1 April 2011 as the date on which the above-mentioned Act shall come into operation. ## MPUMALANGA LOCAL GOVERNMENT LAWS REPEAL ACT, 2005 (ACT No. 9 OF 2005)

To provide for the repeal of certain laws in so far as they are applicable in the Province and to provide for matters connected therewith.

- Definitions. In this Act, unless the context otherwise indicates –
   "Province" means the Province of Mpumalanga established in terms of section 103 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 (Act No. 106 of 1996).
- Repeal of laws. The laws mentioned in the second column of the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent indicated in the third column thereof, in so far as they are applicable in the Province.
- 3. Savings. The repeal of a law mentioned in the second column of the Schedule to this Act does not –
- (a) Revive anything not in force or existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect;
- (b) Affect the previous operation of any law so repealed or anything duly done or suffered under the law so repealed;
- Affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under any law so repealed;
- (d) Affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any law so repealed.
- 4. Short title and commencement. This Act, is called the Mpumalanga Local Government Laws Repeal Act, 2005 and comes into operation on a date determined by the Premier by proclamation in the *Provincial Gazette*.
