PROCLAMATION  
BY THE  
PREMIER OF THE PROVINCE OF MPUMALANGA

**No. 1, 2011**

**TRANSFER OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FUNCTION FROM DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
WORKS, ROADS AND TRANSPORT TO DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY, SECURITY AND  
LIAISON**

I, **David Dabede Mabuza** in my capacity as the Premier of the Province of Mpumalanga hereby, in terms of section 132(2) read with section 137 of the Constitution, 1996, read further with section 3A(b) of the Public Service Act, 1994, and read further with Treasury Regulation 6.5 of the Treasury Regulations, 2005, transfer, with effect from 1 June 2011, the following functions as set out in Schedules 4 and 5 to the Constitution, 1996, from the Provincial Department of Public Works, Roads and Transport, to the Provincial Department of Safety, Security and Liaison:

- Road traffic regulation;
- Vehicle licensing;
- Provincial traffic;
- The monitoring and support of Local Government and the regulation of the exercise of executive authority by Municipalities, in respect of traffic and parking.
