TRANSFER TO LEKWA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

Transferring Department	Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (DEDET).
Purpose of Allocation	To provide financial assistance to Lekwa Municipality in resolving the supply of electricity to the Oilseed Crushing Plant.
Measurable Outputs	Creation of 150 direct jobs and 4000 indirect jobs when the plant is fully operational.
Allocation Criteria	Lekwa Local Municipality to pay Eskom the lump sum, in resolving the supply of electricity to the Plant.
Monitoring Systems	<p>A service level agreement between Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism and Lekwa municipality is entered into with specific timeframes.</p> <p>The Provincial Treasury will monitor that funds are transferred to all stakeholders as per the conditions set out in the service level agreement and payment schedule</p>
Budget on which transfer is shown	Allocated under Programme 3: Strategic Initiatives
Projected Life	The gazette deals specifically with transfer of funds and not the projected life of project.
Payment Schedule	<p>A once off transfer amounting to R20 million will be made as soon as a service level agreement is concluded.</p> <p>The transfer shall be made by the Provincial Treasury to the Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism from the Provincial Revenue Fund on 12 March 2014 immediately after the tabling of Provincial second adjustment appropriation bill to the Provincial Legislature.</p> <p>The Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism shall transfer funding as appropriated under Transfers and Subsidies to the designated bank account of Lekwa local municipality on 13 March 2014.</p> <p>Lekwa local municipality shall transfer funding to ESKOM on or before 31 March 2014.</p>
