

ADOPTION OF NEW BY-LAWS FOR THE

MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF INFORMAL

SETTLEMENTS BY-LAW

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 160(4)(b) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 (Act 108 of 1996) read with Section 12(3)(b) of the Local Government Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act 32 of 2000) that the Umjindi Municipality intends adopting new By-Laws for the management and Control of informal Settlements applicable on the whole area of jurisdiction of Umjindi Municipality.

The purpose of adopting the new By-Laws for management and control of informal settlements is to put measures of control in place for land invasion and other unlawful occupation of land.

The said By-Laws are open for inspection by interested parties at the office of the Human Settlements Section (Municipal Offices) for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this notice.

Any person who wishes to make representations concerning adoption of the new By-Laws for management and control of informal settlements, or wishes to lodge objections against the adoption of the By-Laws, must do so in writing within the period of 14 (fourteen) days at the under mentioned address.

Late objections/representations will not be considered.

People who are challenged in terms of reading and/or writing skills are welcome to visit the Municipal Offices personally during normal office hours where they will be assisted by personnel to formulate their written representations/objections.
