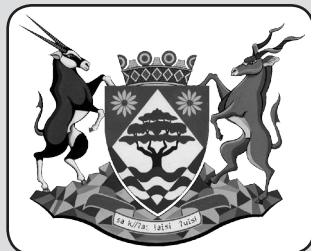

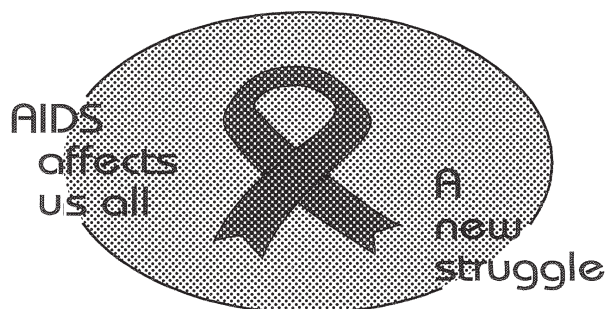

**GAMAGARA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY****WATER USE LICENSE/GENERAL AUTHORIZATION
APPLICATION FOR THE NEW KATHU CEMETERY
PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS**

The Gamagara Local Municipality proposes to develop additional space for graves in the town of Kathu. The existing cemetery is nearing capacity and thus additional space is necessary due to the rapid expansion of the town of Kathu, which is partly due to the resettlement of the Dingleton residents. A new cemetery will be developed on the remaining extent of the farm Lylyveld (or Lyleveld) 545, 13km south of Kathu. The New Kathu Cemetery will be approximately 5 hectares in extent on land owned by the Sishen Iron Ore Company. The land for the new cemetery will be transferred to the Gamagara Local Municipality through a land swap agreement as part of the Dingleton Resettlement project.

Water uses being applied for: Section 21 (c) and (i) [impeding/altering a watercourse] of the National Water Act (NWA; No. 36 of 1998) for infrastructure (access road, access point, fencing and new Dingleton road intersection) within the 1:100 year floodline of the Ga-Mogara River.

Application: Will be submitted to Department of Water and Sanitation in terms of Regulation No. 267 (24 March 2017) of the NWA.

Any queries, comments and/or objections to the application are to be received in writing by the person listed below by no later than **5 May 2017**
