Omskrywings

1. In hierdie Wet, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken —

“**dier**” enige perd, bees, donkie, skaap, bok, vark, volstruis, hond, kat, of die kruising van enige sodanige dier, en “**diere**” het ’n ooreenstemmende betekenis;

“**eienaar**” met inbegrip van die eienaar wat bekend is, of wie se identiteit met redelike ywer vasgestel kan word rakende enige

(a) dier, met inbegrip van die agent van die eienaar of ander persoon wat wettiglik oor sodanige dier toesig het of in besit daarvan is; of

(b) grond, met inbegrip van die eienaar, huurder of wettige bewoner van sodanige grond of sy of haar agent;

“**hierdie Wet**” met inbegrip van die regulasies;

“**LUR**” die lid van die Uitvoerende Raad verantwoordelik vir plaaslike regering;

“**munisipaliteit**” ’n munisipaliteit wat ingevolge artikel 155(6) van die Grondwet, 1996 ingestel is;

“**regulasies**” die regulasies uitgevaardig soos bedoel in artikel 31;

“**skut**” ’n skut ingestel soos bedoel in artikel 3;

“**skutmeester**” enige persoon aangestel soos bedoel in artikel 5 met inbegrip van enige persoon wat namens die aangestelde skutmeester optree;

“**voorgeskrif**” by regulasie voorgeskryf, en “**voorgeskrewe**” het ’n ooreenstemmende betekenis;

Toepassing en administrasie van hierdie Wet

2. Hierdie Wet is op alle munisipaliteite in KwaZulu-Natal van toepassing en word deur die LUR geadmistreer: Met dien verstande dat dit nie meer in enige munisipaliteit van krag is waar ’n skut tot die bevrediging van die LUR ingestel en bedryf word ingevolge ’n munisipale verordening wat in ooreenstemming met hierdie Wet aanvaar is nie.

Instelling van skutte

3. Elke munisipaliteit moet ’n skut instel soos voorgeskryf.

Skutte ingestel ingevolge die Natal Skutordonnansie, 1947

4. Dit word geag dat alle skutte wat ingevolge die Natal Skutordonnansie, 1947 ingestel is, en voor die uitvaardiging van hierdie Wet bestaan het, ingevolge hierdie Wet ingestel is: Met dien verstande dat enige sodanige skut gesluit moet word soos voorgeskryf indien ’n skut in die betrokke munisipaliteit ingestel word soos bedoel in artikel 3.

Aanstelling van skutmeester

5. Elke munisipaliteit moet ’n skutmeester aanstel soos voorgeskryf.

Skutmeesters aangestel ingevolge die Natal Skutordonnansie, 1947

6. Dit word geag dat alle skutmeesters wat ingevolge die Natal Skutordonnansie, 1947 aangestel is, en voor die inwerkingtreding van hierdie Wet as sodanig hulle ampte beklee het, skutmeesters is wat ingevolge hierdie Wet aangestel is tot dat die betrokke munisipaliteit ’n skut soos bedoel in artikel 3 instel.

Ootredende of loslopende diere mag geskut word

7. (1) Die eienaar van enige grond waarop enige dier oortree, mag sodanige dier vang: Met dien verstande dat voordat hy of sy sodanige dier na ’n skut wegneem, kennis aan die eienaar gegee moet word soos voorgeskryf.

(2) Enige dier wat sonder toesig op enige openbare pad of plek rondloop, kan gevang word deur —

(a) ’n lid van die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisie; of

(b) ’n lid van die KwaZulu-Natal Padverkeersinspektoraat;

(c) ’n lid van enige munisipale beskermingsdiens;

(d) ’n skutmeester soos bedoel in artikel 5; of

(e) die eienaar van enige grond waarvoor of waarlangs sodanige pad loop of grens aan sodanige openbare plek.

(3) Geen persoon mag ’n dier vang, met die doel om dit te skut soos bedoel in subartikel (1) en (2), en vir langer as ses uur hou sonder om aan die dier voldoende voedsel en water te verskaf nie.

Diere te kwaai, weerspannig of wild om na die skut aangejaag te word

8. Indien ’n staatsveearts of amptenaar bedoel in artikel 7(2)(a) - (c) oortuig is dat ’n dier wat op enige grond oortree of sonder toesig op enige openbare pad of plek rondloop, te gevaarlik kwaai, weerspannig of wild is, kan hy of sy toestemming verleen vir die genadige afmaak of ander beskikking oor die dier: Met dien verstande dat kennisgewing van sodanige afmaak of ander beskikking oor en die redes daarvoor aan die eienaar van die dier gegee moet word soos voorgeskryf.

Loslating van diere voor wegneming na skut

9. Die eienaar van enige dier wat gevang is met die doel om geskut te word, mag aansoek doen vir die loslating van die dier voordat die dier na die skut weggeneem word, in welke geval die persoon wat die dier gevang het —

(a) sodanige dier onverwyld moet loslaat indien die dier gevang is soos bedoel in artikel 7(2);

(b) sodanige dier onverwyld kan loslaat indien die dier gevang is soos bedoel in artikel 7(1); en

(c) die Hof met jurisdiksie moet nader op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word om die dier te skut in die geval waar die loslating van die dier geweier word, of met die oog daarop om skadevergoeding te eis vir skade wat hy of sy mag gely het.

Versorging van ootredende diere

10. Niemand mag enige dier wat op enige grond oortree of terwyl die dier na ’n skut weggenem word, laat werk, gebruik of mishandel nie.

Skut waarheen diere geneem moet word

11. Enige dier wat gevang word met die doel om dit te skut soos bedoel in artikel 7, moet na die naaste toeganklike skut weggeneem word met die kortste moontlike roete in die kortste moontlike tyd: Met dien verstande dat diere van verskillende spesies volgens hulle spesie geskei moet word.

Inligting wat aan die skutmeester verstrekk moet word oor diere wat na die skut gestuur word

12. Elkeen wat diere na die skut stuur, moet die skutmeester skriftelik in kennis stel van —

(a) die aantal en die beskrywing van die diere;

(b) die grond waarop hulle oortree het; en

(c) die kilometerafstand tussen die plek op sodanige grond en die skut met die kortste moontlike roete.

Ontvangs by skut van diere wat geskut moet word

13. 'n Skutmeester mag nie weier om 'n dier te ontvang en te skut nie.

Skutregister

14.(1) Elke skutmeester moet —

- (a) in die formaat wat voorgeskryf word 'n skutregister byhou wat op alle redelike tye vir openbare inspeksie beskikbaar moet wees; en
- (b) onmiddellik, na ontvangs van enige dier in die skut, sulke inskrywings in die skutregister maak as wat vereis word.

(2) Enige skutmeester wat —

- (a) nalaat of weier om te voldoen aan enige bepalings van subartikel (1);
- (b) opsetlik 'n valse inskrywing in die skutregister maak;
- (c) op bedrieglike wyse enige vorige inskrywing in die skutregister vernietig of uitwis; of
- (d) met opset 'n onjuiste afskrif of uittreksel uit die skutregister aan iemand voorsien,

is skuldig aan 'n misdryf.

Kennisgewing aan eienaars van geskutte diere

15. Wanneer die naam van die eienaar van enige geskutte dier —

- (a) bekend is aan die skutmeester; of
- (b) vasgestel kan word met redelike ywer,

moet die skutmeester die eienaar onverwyld op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word van die skut in kennis stel.

Versorging van geskutte diere

16.(1) 'n Skutmeester —

- (a) is verantwoordelik vir die behoorlike versorging en voer van alle geskutte diere; en
- (b) is teenoor die eienaar van 'n geskutte dier verantwoordelik vir enige skade wat deur sy of haar opsetlike nalatige handeling of versuim veroorsaak word.

(2) Indien 'n Hof met jurisdiksie oortuig is dat 'n geskutte dier gevaarlik kwaai, permanent ongeskik of ongeneeslik siek is, kan hy die vernietiging van of ander beskikking oor die dier magtig: Met dien verstande sodanige kennisgewing van vernietiging of beskikking oor en die redes daarvoor op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word aan die eienaar van die geskutte dier verstrek word.

Afsondering van besmette diere

17. Enige skut wat ingevolge hierdie Wet ingestel word, moet afsonderlike huisvesting vir diere voorsien wat met enige siekte bedoel in die Wet op Dieresiektes, 1984 (Wet No. 35 van 1984) besmet is, en indien die skutmeester redelike gronde het om te vermoed dat 'n geskutte dier of dier wat geskut gaan word met enige sodanige siekte besmet is, moet hy die dier onmiddellik afsonder en die siekte aan die naaste staatsveearts rapporteer.

Geskutte diere mag nie werk nie

18. Die skutmeester mag nie 'n geskutte dier laat werk of op enige wyse van hom gebruik maak nie of toelaat dat enige ander persoon so 'n dier laat werk of van hom gebruik maak nie, en alle manlike diere moet te alle tye afsonderlik van vroulike diere gehou word.

Vrekte of besering van geskutte dier

19. Indien 'n geskutte dier vrek of beseer word, moet die skutmeester 'n beskrywing van sodanige dier en die oorsaak van die dier se vrekke of besering in die skutregister aanteken: Met dien verstande dat kennisgewing van sodanige vrekke of besering op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word aan die eienaar van die geskutte dier gegee word.

Afskrifte van Wet

20. Die skutmeester moet verseker dat afskrifte van hierdie Wet in Engels, Zoeloe en Afrikaans by alle skutte ter insae van lede van die publiek beskikbaar is.

Gelde betaalbaar aan skutmeester

21. Die skutmeester is geregtig om —

- (a) gelde van die eienaars van geskutte diere te vorder teen die tariewe wat voorgeskryf word; en
- (b) die koste van dip, veeartsenykundige behandeling, enting of ander behandeling in ooreenstemming met enige wet te verhaal.

Loslating van geskutte diere

22. (1) Die skutmeester moet onmiddellik 'n geskutte dier loslaat en 'n kwitansie wat voorgeskryf word aan die eienaar oorhandig as die eienaar —

- (a) bewys van eienaarskap van sodanige diere lewer; en
- (b) aan die skutmeester die gelde en koste bedoel in artikel 21 wat voorgeskryf word, betaal.

(2) Indien die loslating van 'n dier versoek word voordat enige skadevergoeding geëis word soos bedoel in artikel 9(c) en deur 'n Hof met jurisdiksie bepaal is, kan die skutmeester, ondanks die bepaling van subartikel (1), weier om sodanige dier los te laat, behalwe op grond van 'n hofbevel.

(3) Indien die eienaar van 'n geskutte dier nie in staat is om die gelde en koste wat voorgeskryf word soos bedoel in artikel 21 te betaal nie, kan die skutmeester sodanige dier terughou met die doel om sodanige gelde en koste te verhaal wat verskuldig of betaalbaar is.

Verkoop van geskutte diere

23. (1) Alle verkope van geskutte diere moet deur 'n Hof met jurisdiksie gemagtig word: Met dien verstande dat die betrokke Hof nie die verkoping kan magtig nie, behalwe as —

- (a) die skutmeester, na kennisgewing aan die eienaar, 'n rekeningstaat voorlê wat al die verskuldigde bedrae ingevolge hierdie Wet uiteensit;
- (b) die bedrae wat in die rekeningstaat bedoel in paragraaf (a) uiteengesit word, nie binne sewe dae na sodanige kennisgewing deur die eienaar betwis word nie; en
- (c) die Hof oortuig is dat die kennisgewing aan die eienaar oorhandig is, of dat die identiteit van die eienaar nie vasgestel kan word nie.

(2) Indien die bedrae wat in die rekeningstaat bedoel in subartikel (1)(a) uiteengesit word, betwis word, moet die Hof die aangeleentheid summier ondersoek en sodanige bevel maak wat hy regverdig en billik ag, met inbegrip van 'n kostebevel.

(3) Alle verkope deur die Hof goedgekeur, moet voldoen aan die prosedure wat voorgeskryf word.

Skutmeester mag nie geskutte diere koop nie

24. Geen skutmeester mag 'n dier wat vir verkoop op 'n skutverkoop aangebied word, persoonlik of deur enige ander persoon, regstreeks of onregstreeks, koop nie

Diere nie suksesvol vir verkoping aangebied nie

25. Indien geen bod vir 'n dier by 'n verkoping gemaak word nie, moet die skutmeester onverwyld die Hof wat die verkoping bedoel in artikel 23 gemagtig het, in kennis stel van die geraamde waarde van die dier en die gelde en koste wat ten opsigte daarvan aangegaan is, en die Hof kan aan die skutmeester sodanige opdragte gee wat hy as regverdig en billik ag: Met dien verstande dat kennisgewing van sodanige onsuksesvolle verkoping op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word aan die eienaar gegee word.

Aanwending van opbrengs van verkoping

26. Die opbrengs van die verkoop van geskutte diere moet in die provinsiale inkomstefonds gestort word.

Waardering van skadevergoeding

27. Die eienaar van enige grond waarop die 'n dier oortree het en wat as gevolg van sodanige oortreding skade gely het, kan op die wyse wat voorgeskryf word, 'n eis om skadevergoeding by die Hof met jurisdiksie indien.

Optrede vir verhaling van skadevergoeding

28. Niks in hierdie Wet verhinder enigeen om 'n geding in enige Hof met jurisdiksie aanhangig te maak om die skadevergoeding te verhaal wat weens die loslopende dier gely is nie.

Verwydering uit skut en onwettige skut

29. Enigeen wat —

- (a) 'n dier verwyder wat wettiglik gevang is met die doel om geskut te word, of wat wettiglik geskut is;
- (b) 'n dier onwettiglik vang met die doel om die dier te skut; of
- (c) 'n dier onwettiglik skut,

is skuldig aan 'n misdryf.

Misdrywe en strawwe

30. Enigeen wat enige van die bepalings van hierdie Wet oortree, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig en by skuldigbevinding strafbaar met gevangenisstraf vir 'n tydperk van hoogstens ses maande of 'n gepaste boete wat ingevolge toepaslike wetgewing vasgestel word.

Regulasies

31. Die LUR kan regulasies uitvaardig wat nie met hierdie Wet strydig is nie en die volgende voorskryf —

- (a) enige aangeleentheid ten opsigte waarvan regulasies kragtens 'n bepaling van hierdie Wet gemagtig word;
- (b) enige aangeleentheid tot die mate wat nodig is om die bepalings van hierdie Wet toe te pas.

Herroeping van wette

32. Die Natal Skutordonnansie, 1947, (Ordonnansie No. 32 van 1947), word hierby herroep.

- (b) kumele akhulule lesi silwane ngaphambi, uma isilwane sasigcinwe njengoba kuhlangozwe esigabeni 7(1); futhi
- (c) angathinta iNkantolo ephethe leyo ndawo ngendlela enqunyiwe, ukuthi afake isilwane esikidi, uma kunqatshiwe ukukhululwa kwesilwane, noma ngenhloso yokufaka isicelo sokukhokhelwa ngomonakalo odalekile.

14. (1) Umgcinisikidi ngamunye kumele —

- (a) agcine irejista yesikidi ngendlela efanele enqunyiwe, okumele itholakale ukuze ihlolwe ngumphakathi ngezikhathi ezifanele; futhi
- (b) ngokushesha, ekwamukelekeni esikidi noma yisiphi isilwane, kumele akubhale lokhu kwirejista.

(2) Noma yimuphi umgcinisikidi —

- (a) oziba noma onqaba ukuhambisana nanoma yiziphi izinhlinzeko zesigatshana (1);
- (b) obhale ngokwazi okungesilo iqiniso kwirejista isikidi; noma
- (c) oshabalalisa noma osula noma yini eyayibhalwe ngaphambilini kwijerista yesikidi; noma
- (d) oletha ikhophi engesilona iqiniso ngenhloso noma okhipha kwirejista yesikidi noma yimuphi umuntu, uzotholaka enecala.

Ukunakekelwa kwezilwane ezivalelwe esikidi

Amakhophi oMthetho

25. Uma isilwane singadayisekanga, umgcinisikidi kumele eluleke iNkantolo egunyaze ukudayiswa njengoba kuhlangoziwe esigabeni 23, senani eliliganisiwe sesilwane kanye nezimali nezindleko ezenzeke ngaleso sikhathi, futhi iNkantolo inganikeza umgcinisikidi leyo miyalelo njengoba ingabona kufanele: Kuncike ekutheni isaziso sokudayisa kumele sinikezelwe ngendlela enqunyiwe kumnikazi wesilwane esivalelwe esikidi.

Ukufakwa kwesicelo sokuqhubeka nokudayisa

26. Zonke izinqubo zokudayiswa kwezilwane ezivalelwe esikidi kumele zikhokhelwe esikhwameni sokuqoqwa kwezimali zomasipala.

Ukuhlolwa komonakalo

27. Umnikazi wanoma yimuphi umhlaba lapho kunqamule khona isilwane ngokungemthetho, futhi kwadaleka nomonakalo ngenxa yokunqamula ngokungemthetho kwaleso silwane, angafaka isicelo sokuqhubeka umonakalo eNkantolo enamandla omthetho, lokhu kwenzeke ngendlela enqunyiwe.

Ukukhululwa kwesikidi kanye nokuvala isilwane esikidi ngokungemthetho

29. Noma yimuphi umuntu —

- (a) okhulula isilwane ebesigcinwe ngokusemthethweni ngenhloso yokufaka isilwane esikidi noma ebesivalelwe esikidi ngokungemthetho;
- (b) ogcina ngokungemthetho isilwane ngenhloso yokusifaka esikidi; noma
- (c) ofaka isilwane esikidi ngokungemthetho,

uyothiswa icala.

Amacala kanye nezinhlawulo

BILL

BE IT ENACTED by the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Legislature, as follows:—

Definitions

1. In this Act, unless inconsistent with the context —

“**animal**” means a horse, bovine, donkey, sheep, goat, pig, ostrich, dog, cat or the hybrid of any such animal, and “**animals**” will have a corresponding meaning;

“MEC” means the member of the KwaZulu-Natal Executive Council responsible for local government;

“municipality” means a municipality established in terms of section 155(6) of the Constitution, 1996;

“owner” includes an owner who is known, or whose identity, with the exercise of reasonable diligence, can be ascertained, and in relation to any—

- (a) animal, includes the agent of the owner or other person having the lawful custody or possession of such animal; or
- (b) land, includes the owner, lessee or lawful occupier of such land, or his or her agent;

“pound” means a pound established as contemplated in section 3;

“poundkeeper” means any person appointed as contemplated in section 5 and includes any person acting for or on behalf of the appointed poundkeeper;

“prescribed” means prescribed by the regulations;

“regulations” means the regulations made as contemplated in section 31; and

“this Act” includes the regulations.

Application and Administration of this Act

2. This Act applies to all municipalities within KwaZulu-Natal, and is administered by the MEC: Provided that it will cease to be of force and effect in any municipality in which a pound, to the satisfaction of the MEC, is established and operated in terms of a municipal bylaw adopted in compliance with this Act.

Establishment of pounds

3. Each Municipality must establish a pound in the prescribed manner.

Pounds established in terms of the Natal Pound Ordinance, 1947

4. All pounds established in terms of the Natal Pound Ordinance, 1947, and in existence prior to the enactment of this Act will be deemed to have been established in terms of this Act, and be subject to the provisions of this Act: Provided that any such pound must be disestablished in the prescribed manner, upon the establishment of a pound in the relevant municipality as contemplated in section 3.

Appointment of poundkeeper

5. Each municipality must appoint a poundkeeper, in the prescribed manner.

Poundkeepers appointed in terms of the Natal Pound Ordinance, 1947

6. All poundkeepers appointed in terms of the Natal Pound Ordinance, 1947, and holding office as such immediately prior to the commencement of this Act, will be deemed to be poundkeepers appointed in terms of this Act, and will hold office subject to the provisions of this Act, until the relevant municipality establishes a pound as contemplated in section 3.

Trespassing or straying animals may be impounded

7.(1) The owner of any land upon which any animal is found trespassing may seize such animal: Provided that before he or she may remove such animal to a pound, notice must be given in the prescribed manner to the owner.

(2) Any animal found straying untended upon any public road or public place may be seized by—

- (a) a member the South African Police Services;
- (b) a member of the KwaZulu-Natal Road Traffic Inspectorate;
- (c) a member of any municipal protection services;
- (d) a poundkeeper appointed as contemplated in section 5; or
- (e) the owner of any land through or alongside which such road passes or which abuts on such public place.

(3) No person may keep an animal seized for the purposes of impounding it, as contemplated in sub-section (1) and (2), for a period longer than six hours without supplying it with adequate food and water.

Animals too vicious, intractable or wild to be driven to the pounded

8. If a State Veterinarian or official contemplated in section 7(2)(a) – (c), is satisfied that an animal found to be trespassing on any land, or straying untended upon any public road or public place, is too dangerously vicious, intractable or wild to be impounded, he or she may authorise the humane destruction or other disposal of the animal: Provided that notice of such destruction or disposal and the reasons therefore must be given in the prescribed manner to the owner of the animal.

Release of animals before removal to pound

9. The owner of any animal, which has been seized for the purposes of impounding it, may apply for its release prior to its removal to the pound, in which event the person who seized the animal —

- (a) must release such animal forthwith, if the animal was seized as contemplated in section 7(2);
- (b) may release such animal forthwith, if the animal was seized as contemplated in section 7(1); and
- (c) must approach the Court with jurisdiction in the prescribed manner, to impound the animal, in the event that the release of the animal was refused, or in order to claim any damages he or she may have suffered.

Care of Trespassing animals

10. No person may work, use or ill-treat any animal found trespassing on any land or whilst it is in the process of being removed to a pound.

Pound to which animals must be taken

11. Any animal which has been seized for the purposes of impounding it as contemplated in section 7, must be removed to the nearest accessible pound, by the shortest practical route, and within the shortest practical time: provided that animals of different species must be separated according to their species.

Information to be supplied to poundkeeper of animals sent to the pound

12. Every person sending animals to the pound must advise the poundkeeper in writing of —

- (a) the numbers and descriptions of the animals;
- (b) the land upon which they were found to be trespassing; and
- (c) the distance in kilometers between the place on such land and the pound by the shortest practical route.

Acceptance at pound of animals to be impounded

13. A poundkeeper may not refuse to accept an animal, for impoundment.

Pound register

14.(1) Each poundkeeper must —

- (a) maintain a pound register in the prescribed format, which must be available for public inspection at all reasonable times; and
- (b) immediately, upon the acceptance into the pound of any animal, make such entries in the pound register as may be required.

(2) Any poundkeeper who —

- (a) neglects or refuses to comply with any of the provisions of sub-section (1);
- (b) knowingly makes a false entry in the pound register;
- (c) fraudulently destroys or erases any previous entry in the pound register; or
- (d) willfully delivers a false copy or extract from the pound register to any person,

will be guilty of an offence.

Notice to owners of impounded animals

15. Whenever the name of the owner of any impounded animal —

- (a) is known to the poundkeeper; or
- (b) can be ascertained with the exercise of reasonable diligence,

the poundkeeper must forthwith notify the owner in the prescribed manner of the impoundment.

Care of impounded animals

16.(1) A poundkeeper —

- (a) is responsible for the proper care and feeding of all impounded animals; and
- (b) will be liable to the owner of an impounded animal for any damage caused by his or her willful or negligent acts or omissions.

(2) If a Court with jurisdiction is satisfied that an impounded animal is dangerously vicious, permanently disabled or terminally ill, it may authorise the destruction or other disposal of the impounded animal: provided that notice of such destruction or disposal and the reasons therefore must be given in the prescribed manner to the owner of the impounded animal.

Isolation of infected animals

17. Any pound established in terms of this Act, must provide separate accommodation for animals infected with any disease contemplated in the Animal Diseases Act, 1984 (Act No. 35 of 1984), and if the poundkeeper has reasonable grounds for suspecting that an impounded animal or to be impounded is infected with any such disease, he or she must immediately isolate the animal and report the diseases to nearest State veterinarian.

Impounded animals not to be worked

18. The poundkeeper may not work or in any way make use of an impounded animal or permit any such animal to be worked or made use of by any other person, and all male animals must at all times be kept apart from female animals.

Death of or injury to impounded animals

19. If an impounded animal dies or is injured, the poundkeeper must enter a description of such animal and the cause of its death or injury in the pound register: provided that notice of such death or injury must be given in the prescribed manner to the owner of the impounded animal.

Copies of Act

20. The poundkeeper must ensure that copies of this Act in English, *isiZulu* and Afrikaans, are available at all pounds for inspection by members of the public.

Fees payable to poundkeeper

21. The poundkeeper will be entitled to —

- (a) charge the owners of an impounded animal the prescribed fees; and
- (b) recover the cost of any dipping, medical treatment, inoculation, or other treatment in accordance with any law.

Release of impounded animals

22.(1) The poundkeeper must immediately release an impounded animal, and give the owner a receipt in the prescribed format, upon the owner—

- (a) providing proof of ownership of such animal; and
- (b) paying to the poundkeeper the prescribed fees and costs contemplated in section 21.

(2) If application for the release of an animal is made before any damages claimed as contemplated under section 9(c) have been assessed by the Court with jurisdiction, the poundkeeper, notwithstanding the provision of subsection (1), must refuse to release such animal, except by order of Court.

(3) If the owner of an impounded animal is unable to pay the prescribed fees or costs contemplated in section 21, the poundkeeper may retain such animal in order to recover such fees or costs as may be due and payable.

Sales of impounded animals

23.(1) All sales of impounded animals must be authorised by a Court with jurisdiction: Provided that the relevant Court may not authorize the sale, unless —

- (a) the poundkeeper, on notice to the owner, lodges a statement setting forth all the amounts due in terms of this Act;
- (b) the amounts set forth in the statement contemplated in paragraph (a) are not disputed by the owner within seven days of such notice; and
- (c) the Court is satisfied that notice has been given to the owner, or that the identity of the owner cannot be ascertained.

(2) Where the amounts set forth in the statement contemplated in subsection (1)(a) are disputed the Court must summarily enquire into the matter and make such order as it considers just and equitable, including an order for costs.

(3) All sales approved by a Court must comply with the prescribed procedure.

Poundkeeper may not purchase impounded animals

24. No poundkeeper may purchase an animal offered for sale at a pound sale, either personally or through any other person, directly or indirectly.

Animals unsuccessfully offered for sale

25. If no offer is made for an animal put up for sale, the poundkeeper must forthwith advise the Court that authorised the sale as contemplated in section 23, of the estimated value of the animal and the fees and costs incurred in respect thereof, and the Court may give the poundkeeper such instructions as it may deem just and equitable: provided that notice of such unsuccessful sale must be given in the prescribed manner to the owner of the impounded animal.

Application of proceeds of sale

26. All proceeds from the sale of impounded animals must be paid into the municipal revenue fund.

Assessment of damage

27. The owner of any land on which an animal has trespassed, and who has suffered damages in consequence of such trespass, may, in the prescribed manner, lodge a claim for damages in the Court with jurisdiction.

Action for recovery of damages

28. Nothing in this Act will prevent any person from instituting action in any Court with jurisdiction for the recovery of damages suffered by reason of a trespassing animal.

Pound rescue and unlawful impounding

29. Any person who —

- (a) rescues an animal which has been lawfully seized for the purpose of being impounded or which has been lawfully impounded;
- (b) unlawfully seizes an animal for the purpose of impounding it; or
- (c) unlawfully impounds an animal,

will be guilty of an offence.

Offences and penalties

30. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Act will be guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to an appropriate fine determined in terms of applicable legislation.

Regulations

31. The MEC may make regulations not inconsistent with this Act, prescribing —

- (a) any matter in respect of which regulations are authorised by any provision of this Act;
- (b) any other matters to the extent necessary to enforce the provisions of this Act.

Repeal of laws

32. The Natal Pound Ordinance, 1947, (Ordinance 32 of 1947), is hereby repealed.

Short title and commencement

33. This Act will be known as the KwaZulu-Natal Pound Act, 2005.
