



1. Rates have been assessed based on property values as contained in the general Valuation Roll. In addition to the first R15,000.00 of the valuation for residential category of properties, which is impermissible in terms of the Municipal Property Rates Act, the Hibiscus Coast Municipality has included a further reduction of R85,000.00 on improved properties and R15,000.00 on vacant land in the calculations, as per the municipality's Rates Policy. In addition to the R100,000 reduction on the valuation for improved residential category mentioned above, pensioners receive rebates on three levels, at 75%, 50% and 25% in terms of paragraph 11(2) of the municipality's Rates Policy read with Section 15(2) of the Municipal Property Rates Act, which will be displayed on the public notice boards at the various units and 100% for child headed households as per council adopted rates policy.
- Certain category 7 Institutions and category 8 special purpose properties do qualify for exemption in terms of paragraph 9 of the municipality's Rates Policy.
