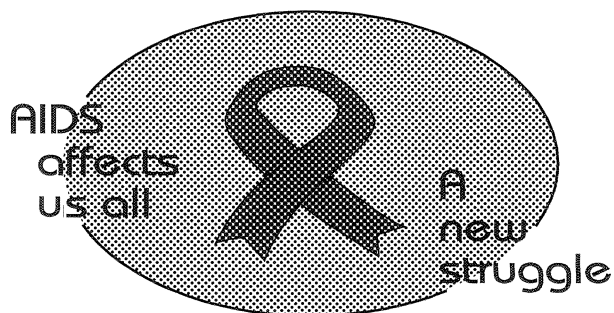

CONDITIONS FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICES

CLOSING TIMES FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF NOTICES

1. (1) The *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette* is published every week on Thursday, and the closing time for the acceptance of notices which have to appear in the *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette* on any particular Thursday, is **15:00 one week prior to the publication date**. Should any Thursday coincide with a public holiday, the publication date remains unchanged. However, the closing date for acceptance of advertisements moves backwards accordingly, in order to allow for 5 working days prior to the publication date.
- (2) The date for the publication of an **Extraordinary** *KwaZulu-Natal Province Provincial Gazette* is negotiable.
2. (1) Notices received **after closing time** will be held over for publication in the next *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette*.
- (2) Amendments or changes in notices cannot be undertaken unless instructions are received **before 10:00 on Fridays**.
- (3) Notices for publication or amendments of original copy can not be accepted over the telephone and must be brought about by letter, by fax or by hand. The Government Printer will not be liable for any amendments done erroneously.
- (4) In the case of cancellations a refund of the cost of a notice will be considered only if the instruction to cancel has been received on or before the stipulated closing time as indicated in paragraph 2(2).

APPROVAL OF NOTICES (This only applies to Private Companies)

3. In the event where a cheque, submitted by an advertiser to the Government Printer as payment, is dishonoured, then the Government Printer reserves the right to refuse such client further access to the *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette* until any outstanding debts to the Government Printer is settled in full.

THE GOVERNMENT PRINTER INDEMNIFIED AGAINST LIABILITY

4. The Government Printer will assume no liability in respect of—
 - (1) any delay in the publication of a notice or publication of such notice on any date other than that stipulated by the advertiser;

Where applicable

- (1) The heading under which the notice is to appear.
(2) The cost of publication applicable to the notice, in accordance with the "Word Count Table".

PAYMENT OF COST (This only applies to Private Companies)

9. **With effect from 26 April 2007 no notice will be accepted for publication unless the cost of the insertion(s) is prepaid in CASH or by CHEQUE or POSTAL ORDERS. It can be arranged that money can be paid into the banking account of the Government Printer, in which case the deposit slip accompanies the advertisement before publication thereof.**
10. (1) The cost of a notice must be calculated by the advertiser in accordance with the word count table.
(2) Where there is any doubt about the cost of publication of a notice, and in the case of copy, an enquiry, accompanied by the relevant copy, should be addressed to the **Advertising Section, Government Printing Works, Private Bag X85, Pretoria, 0001 [Fax: (012) 323-8805]**, *before publication*.
11. ASSESSMENT OF GENERAL RATES FOR 2012 / 2013

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 14 of the Local Government Municipal Property Rates Act No. 6 of 2004, that by resolution no. 12/394 taken on 29 May 2012 the council of Mthonjaneni Municipality has resolved to determine the rates payable on all ratable property within the area of Mthonjaneni Municipality for the financial year 1 July 2012 to 30 June 2013 as 1.24c/R in the rand on the market value of all property other than agricultural property and public service infrastructure and 0.31c/R in the rand for agricultural properties and public service infrastructure as stated in the valuation roll.

The following rebates have been approved as per the above Council resolution:

- Agricultural 5%
- State 20%
- Residential 20%
- All properties other than state, agricultural, residential and public service infrastructure 16%
- Public service infrastructure compulsory 30%

General:

1. Rates will be payable monthly in ten (10) equal installments with the first installment payable on 31 August 2012 and the last installment payable on 31 May 2013.
2. The date on which the determination of rates came into operation is 1 July 2012.
3. Any rates remaining unpaid for a period longer than 3 months will be subject to legal action, action to be instituted to recover the arrear amount.
4. Any rates that are not paid on the due date will be subject to interest at the rate of 1,5% per month or part thereof;

KWAZULU-NATAL DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE & ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS**NOMINATION OF PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED TO THE KWAZULU-NATAL NATURE CONSERVATION BOARD**

The KwaZulu-Natal Nature Conservation Board is the successor in title to the Natal Parks Board and the Directorate: Nature Conservation. The primary functions of the Board are to direct the management of nature conservation within the Province and protected areas; to develop and promote ecotourism within the protected areas and to develop and promote conservation partnerships with people in KwaZulu-Natal.

In terms of Section 4(4) of the KwaZulu-Natal Nature Conservation Management Act 9 of 1997, I hereby invite written nominations with motivation, from members of the public, and or organisations for persons who could be considered for appointment to vacancies on the KwaZulu-Natal Nature Conservation Board. Proposed persons must have an interest in nature conservation and must be drawn from categories mentioned in Section 4 of the Act, which are currently vacant and which are summarised below:

- (i) Section 4(8)(a)(i) One person nominated by the House of Traditional Leaders;
- (ii) Section 4(8)(a)(ii) One person from non-governmental organisations, institutions or groups established for the advancement of nature conservation or environmental protection within the province;
- (iii) Section 4(8)(b)(i) One person from Community Based Organisations in rural areas in the Province;
- (iv) Section 4(8)(b)(ii) One person with extensive knowledge of the Business Sector;
- (v) Section 4(8)(b)(iii) One person with knowledge and experience of environmental law;
- (vi) Section 4(8)(b)(iv) One person nominated by the Provincial Tourism Authority;
- (vii) Section 4(8)(b)(v) One person with extensive knowledge & experience of labour matters;
- (viii) Section 4(8)(b)(vi) One person from organised agriculture;
- (ix) Section 4(8)(b)(vii) One person with extensive knowledge of the protection and management of heritage resources; and
- (x) Section 4(8)(c) Three persons, selected by the Minister, to enhance the competence of the Board.

I am seeking to appoint Board Members to the categories as set out above.

A person cannot be appointed as a member of the Board if such a person-

- (i) Is or becomes a member of the National or Provincial Parliaments, or an official or employee contemplated in the Public Service Act, or, save for the Chief Executive Officer contemplated in terms of subsection (10), a member of the Conservation Service;
- (ii) is an unrehabilitated insolvent, or becomes insolvent and the Insolvency results in the sequestration of his or her estate;
- (iii) is declared to be of unsound mind by a court of the Republic; or
- (iv) since the date on which the Constitution came into effect, has been or is convicted of an offence and sentenced to more than 12 months' imprisonment without the option of a fine, either in the Republic, or outside the Republic if the conduct constituting the offence would have been an offence in the Republic, but no one may be regarded as having been sentenced until an appeal against the conviction or sentence has been determined, or until the time for an appeal has expired. A disqualification under this paragraph ends five years after the sentence has been completed.

Persons shall be appointed for a period of three (3) years or such lesser period as I, BM Radebe, MEC for Agriculture and Environmental Affairs may determine, in terms of Section 6 of the Act.

Nominations must be accompanied by the nominee's written acceptance of nominations and a comprehensive curriculum vitae. Nominees are further requested to submit to the Minister a written statement declaring whether or not he or she is disqualified for any reasons mentioned above.
