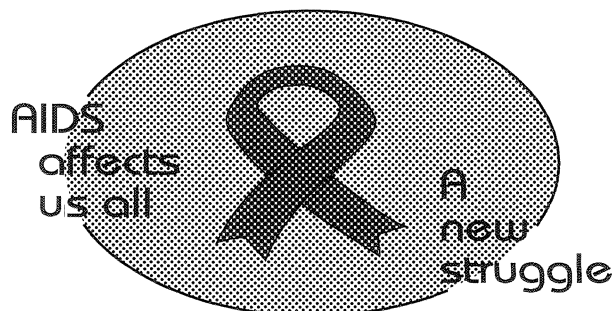

CLOSING TIMES FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF NOTICES

1. (1) The *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette* is published every week on Thursday, and the closing time for the acceptance of notices which have to appear in the *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette* on any particular Thursday, is **15:00 one week prior to the publication date**. Should any Thursday coincide with a public holiday, the publication date remains unchanged. However, the closing date for acceptance of advertisements moves backwards accordingly, in order to allow for 5 working days prior to the publication date.
- (2) The date for the publication of an **Extraordinary** *KwaZulu-Natal Province Provincial Gazette* is negotiable.
2. (1) Notices received **after closing time** will be held over for publication in the next *KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Gazette*.
- (2) Amendments or changes in notices cannot be undertaken unless instructions are received **before 10:00 on Fridays**.
- (3) Notices for publication or amendments of original copy can not be accepted over the telephone and must be brought about by letter, by fax or by hand. The Government Printer will not be liable for any amendments done erroneously.
- (4) In the case of cancellations a refund of the cost of a notice will be considered only if the instruction to cancel has been received on or before the stipulated closing time as indicated in paragraph 2(2).

3. AMENDMENT TO THE SWIMMING POOL BYLAWS

The uMhlathuze Municipality has, in terms of Section 156 of the Constitution, 1996 (Act No 108 of 1996) read in conjunction with section 12(3) of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act No 32 of 2000), passed a resolution for the amendment of the Swimming Pool Bylaws. The following are the applicable amendments to the Swimming Pool Bylaws as promulgated in the Provincial Gazette Number 6113 under Notice Number 19 dated 4 July 2002, which shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof:

1. The reference to "10 (ten)" in Section 5(3) is to be amended to "15 (fifteen)". Section 5(3) will then read as follows:

"5(3) The authorized official may refuse to permit any person to enter the municipal swimming pool "15 (fifteen)" minutes before the official closing time."

2. The words "15 (fifteen) minutes" are to be added to Section 5(4), which will then read as follows:

5(4) All visitors must leave the municipal swimming pool or swimming pool enclosure "15 minutes prior to" closing time or when instructed to do so by the authorized official.

AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC LIBRARIES BYLAWS

The uMhlathuze Municipality has, in terms of Section 156 of the Constitution, 1996 (Act No 108 of 1996) read in conjunction with section 12(3) of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act No 32 of 2000), passed a resolution for the amendment of the Public Libraries Bylaws. The following are the applicable amendments to the Public Libraries Bylaws as promulgated in the Provincial Gazette Number 6096 under Notice Number 9 dated 11 April 2002, which shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof:

1. The word "*poster*" is to be added to the definition of "*library material or item*" under the definitions and the words "*framed art*" are to be deleted. The definition will then read as follows:

"library material" or "item" shall mean any book, magazine, document, print, newspaper, "poster" map, audio or visual tape, compact disc, DVD's or similar publication;

AMENDMENT TO THE WATER SERVICES BYLAWS

The uMhlathuze Municipality has, in terms of Section 156 of the Constitution, 1996 (Act No 108 of 1996) read in conjunction with section 12(3) of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act No 32 of 2000), passed a resolution for the amendment of the Water Services Bylaws. The following are the applicable amendments to the Water Services Bylaws as promulgated in the Provincial Gazette Number 6021 under Notice Number 11 dated 26 April 2001, which shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof:

1. The words "*which requires authorization for its disposal via the sea outfall effluent pipeline owned by the nominated water services provider*" in the definition of "industrial effluent" are to be deleted. The definition will then read as follows:

"industrial effluent" means any liquid whether or not containing matter in solution or suspension, which is given off in the course of or as a result of any industrial trade, manufacturing, mining or chemical process or any laboratory, research or agricultural activity, and includes for the purposes of these By-laws, any effluent other than domestic effluent or storm water, and "trade effluent" bears the same meaning;

2. The words "*and quality*" are to be added to Section 91(b), which will then read as follows:

*"91(b) install such equalizing tanks, valves, pumps, appliances, meters and other equipment or technology as in the opinion of an authorised official will be necessary to control the rate and time "**and quality**" of discharge into the sewage disposal system in accordance with the conditions imposed by the authorised official;*

3. The contents of section 86(2), is to be deleted and replaced to read as follows:

"86(2) No person shall discharge sewage into the Municipality's facilities by road haulage, unless he or she has made an application to the Municipality to authorise the discharge and the application has been accepted, provided also, that any discharge is subject to any conditions that may have been imposed by the Municipality and in accordance with the written permission of an authorised official."

4. Add two further sections under section 86(2) as new sections 86(3) and 86(4) to read as follows:

"86(3) If, in the opinion of the authorised official, the capacity of the sewage disposal system is sufficient to permit the conveyance, effective treatment and lawful disposal of the industrial effluent, the authorised official may, for such period and subject to such conditions as the authorised official may impose, grant written permission in terms of subsection (1)."

"86(4) A person to whom such permission is granted shall pay to the Municipality any fee (including but not limited to, any administration fee) that may be prescribed. Fees relating to the acceptance of any domestic or industrial effluent shall be calculated in accordance with Schedules B and C, subject to the proviso that such tariff of fees is reasonable in the circumstances."

5. The numbering of the further subsections will then be amended as follows:
The current Sections 86(3) – 86(6) will be amended to reflect Sections 86(5) – 86(8).
6. Section 88(1) is to be deleted and replaced to read as follows:

“88(1) No person shall discharge or cause or permit to be discharged into the sewage disposal system, unless he or she has made an application to the Municipality to authorise the discharge and the application has been accepted, provided also, that any discharge is subject to any conditions that may have been imposed by the Municipality and in accordance with the written permission of an authorised official.”
