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**NOTICE 117 OF 2009****DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
AND HOUSING****ALLOCATION, OTHER THAN AN ALLOCATION LISTED IN ANY  
SCHEDULE OF THE DIVISION OF REVENUE ACT NO. 2 OF 2008**

The following schedule is published in terms of Section 15(2) of the Division of Revenue Act No. 2 of 2008, which stipulates that “a Provincial Accounting officer intending to make an allocation in the financial year other than allocation listed in any schedule of this act, to a municipality from the Provincial Fund must, not later than 14 days after the act takes effect or such other date determined by the National Treasury, provide the Provincial Treasury with the prescribed information, and the Provincial Treasury must, not later than the date determine by the National Treasury publish such information in the Provincial Gazette”

<b>Name of the Transferring Department</b>	<b>Provincial Department of Developmental Local Government and Housing</b>
<b>Name of allocation</b>	<b>Municipal Support: Implementation of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act, 2004</b>
<b>Purpose of Allocation</b>	<p>To assist municipalities to cover the cost of the compilation of a Valuation roll in terms of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act, 2004 for the entire jurisdiction area of the municipality, which will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Compilation of valuation rolls,</li> <li>• Data collection on all rateable properties,</li> <li>• Collecting of postal addresses of property owners,</li> <li>• Processing and review of objections,</li> <li>• Attending to valuation enquiries on behalf of the municipality,</li> <li>• Attending Valuation Appeal Board hearings.</li> </ul>
<b>Measurable Outputs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Successful implementation of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act, 2004 at the municipalities</li> </ul>
<b>Conditions</b>	An implementation Task Team has been established in each municipality consisting of councillors and official from the municipality, the Municipal Valuer appointed by the municipality and an official from the Department for Developmental Local Government and Housing that will monitor the implementation processes of the MPRA on a monthly basis.
<b>Allocation criteria</b>	Funds will be allocated to the one local municipality who will pay the service provider.
<b>Reasons for not incorporating this funds within the Equitable Share</b>	The Equitable Share is mainly used to fund free basic services in order to subsidize the indigents in the municipalities.
<b>Monitoring Mechanisms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monthly progress reports will be submitted</li> <li>• The Implementation Task Teams held progress meetings on a monthly basis in order to monitor progress and assess the impact on delivery.</li> </ul>
<b>Past Performance</b>	This is a new Support Programme to municipalities
<b>Projected Life</b>	The department will help to fund the cost of the compilation of the Valuation Rolls for the three municipalities in terms of the MPRA, and the certified valuation rolls have to be submitted to the Municipal Managers by latest 31 January 2009
<b>Payment Schedule</b>	A once-off payment to the Local Municipality
<b>Capacity and Preparedness of the Transferring Department</b>	The Department through the Directorate Municipal Finance will be monitoring the utilization of this funds and proper reporting on the fund will be submitted to management on a monthly and quarterly basis. Municipalities will be request to open a separate bank account where the funds will be deposit into and official of the directorate will have co-signature to this account
